PRIME CATTLE:47 HEAD

Increased numbers across all sections was offered to a packed ringside of buyers with 9 men purchasing. Talk of the week had been about the difficult marketing conditions, due to cheap imports, abundance of boxed meat in the system and difficulty in securing slots at abattoirs, however the auction system showed it true worth with buyers at ringside bidding freely for all types of cattle at slightly less rates.

BULLS:5 HEAD

Quality and weight everywhere in the entry, saw demand strong with numbers proving short of buyers requirements. A heavy, heavyweight Simmental bull topped the section at 178p per kilo, from Rob Evans. Another bull from the same pen topped the price per head at £1415.56. Salers from Messrs Tacy grossed £1209.46 and as ever more could be sold to advantage.

STEERS:17 HEAD

A mixed entry for breed, weight and shape saw demand good with the section benefitting from the extra buyer presence. Topping the section was Heavyweight Limousin from Steve Webster at 195p, Angus's sold to 192p from Clarke Farm. A tremendous wagon of Heavyweight dairy Blue X's from Nigel Parrott sold to 188p. Top price per head was £1384.20 from Nigel who sold others to £1326.

HEIFERS:25 HEAD

Excellent numbers were easily accommodated by the buyers at ringside, several runs of cattle were well ripe, but met good competition when sold. As ever butchers heifers were in most demand topping at 213p from Parry Walters who sold others to 209p. Messrs Reay sold others to 208p. Perhaps the trade of the day were the commercial heifers regularly between 180-195p. Top Price per head was £1316.25 for Limousin from Steve Webster.

OTM's AND COWS:20 HEAD

An excellent entry met good competition throughout and more could be easily sold, otm's sold to 182p for an Angus Steer from Mr. C. McNally who sold others to 178p. Limousin's sold to 169p from JMT Engineering, who sold heifers to 173p. Cows sold to 132p for an Angus from Messrs Bryson, with aged Limousin's to 125p from Mr. Pritchett. Top price per head was £1179.75 from Badby for a Simmental, with others £1175 from Fair Haven. FARMERS: Maximum commission in the ring is £25 a head.

Prime Hoggs: 1490 Forward SQQ 199p/kg

A massively reduced number of Hoggs as the weekends weather stopped a few from drawing Hoggs. A yarding made up mainly of long distance travelers with large number of Romney Hoggs from the Cliffs of Dover and full consignment from Southampton District. An SQQ of 199p/kg represents a lift in trade with the overall quality of the yarding being particularly poor. Export Hoggs though in high demand whilst heavy Hoggs looking a hard fix with buyers having to be talked in to purchases at any rate. In the Spec Hoggs top today of 218p/kg for Kingston Blount Farms at 41kg with P Kane, Shipston on Stour 217p/kg for overnight Hoggs with others benefiting from clipping and dry backs I & T Greenfield seeing 38kg to 217p/kg equal with J Arthers, Coventry at 41kg, RHE Levinge, Staines 41kg and R Tofield, Buckingham 41.5kg. In the heavies a super Beltex from Henry Tustian to 230p/kg at 46kg whilst first time vendor A Mitchell, Naesby saw 48kg at 193p/kg and Mark Bailey, Stoke on Trent 46kg 193p/kg. In the lump Euro weights topping out at £93 for 44kg from Kingston Blount Farms with £92 for 44kg from P & S Nevilles clipped Hoggs. Kingston Blount also £90.50 for 43.5kg. Heavies hard all the way through with two accounts not even travelling to buy, as they opt not to trade imprudently and face a selling trade below cost. Again some weekly buyers of heavies sticking to a self-imposed weight limit of 47kg. Heavies though topping at £106 for Henry Tustian at 46kg. Stan and Pete Collinswoos £100 for 59kg with others £93 and J & J Tredwell 53kg to £93. Meated Export Hoggs a trade comparable to last year. Heavies over supplied Nationally with reports that selling prices struggling to compete with lack of Supermarket trade and cheaper imports. Sheep again dirty today and vendors warned Hoggs may be thrown in the bin.
