On Monday 4th July Rugby Farmers Auction Mart held their weekly sale of Primestock.

In the fat cattle ring, trade once again has taken a step forward with all classes dearer again on the week. Numbers going tighter nationally already, before we've even seen the combines in the fields.

Strong smart bullocks in the 650/750kg over the 286ppk.

Native bred thick heifers (O+ Herefords and Angus) would easily sell to 255ppk and above.

Heifers - 36 forward selling to 302 ppk from Pete Jarrom, Leicester purchased by Mr Andrew Mutch of Mutch Meats. Grossing heifer of the day was from Nigel Foster, Fullready at £1846.76 purchased by Mr Dennis Grant on behalf of local quality butchers -Joseph Morris Butchers.

Bullocks - 16 forward sold to 313ppk from Nigel and Simon Johnson, Lutterworth purchased again by Mutch Meats or lead grossing bullock £2128.60 from new vendors HF Bowley, Buckinghamshire purchased by Mr David Sandham, Sandham Trading Ltd.

10 of the 16 bullocks forward grossing over £1900!!

Young Bulls 16 forward sold to 268ppk from Oli Pritchett, purchased by David Sandham or £1644 from Rosie Leach.

A much lighter show of bulls in terms of weight. Not big boys today tipping the scales to get over the £2000 bracket but never the less. A sound trade for what was sold.

13 OTM and Cull Cows forward.

Again cows just in the world of their own. Topping the day at 236ppk was The Fountaine Family from Beachampton at 236ppk or £1792.30.

The 12 cows forward average 205ppk or even better £1541 per head.

Please note that those that complain about queuing should be aware we had only 520 Ewes booked in for the sale today. Staffing such a greater increase does require some warning.

A record number of Ewes for RFM today selling over 2000. Trade as predicted back as numbers pour out across the Country for Quarbani with Abattoirs all but fully stocked for the festival. Some common misconceptions on the festival lead Vendors to believe they require all Ewes whatever the grade. In truth Quarbani Ewes only qualify for a certain weight classification. Those falling into this sector enjoyed a smart trade only £5 back on the week with lean Ewes and lightweight Ewes £10 to £25 back on the week with normal Ewe Sale orders now not being processed through this period of Festival. No real show stopping Ewes today but Large Lleyn Rams to £182 for Sensecalls with Charolais Ewes from B Cooper to £182 and Texel x from R Heckford £175. Pens of 22 to to £172 with Texels to £175 for J Jackson. Continental Shape all above £170. Suffolks today selling to £165 from M Squire and £164 from D Wadland whilst Mules hitting the Quarbani requirements to £168 from Philly Batchelor others £155 for RFS Ltd and £100 for Welsh Mules from P Jarrom with 43 in a pen from G R Hallifield to £143. Mules generally £130 mark. Lean
