More about today as people draw hard. Quality again very variable with a lot of undershot Lambs forward today. More buyers on ringside and following over exaggerated drops by the deadweight firms last Friday a pleasing stand on SQQ of 340p/kg despite a fall in quality on the whole. Proper spring lambs holding a massive premium today selling generally north of 350p/kg throughout as buyers report last week an unprecedented poor Kills percentage for the time of year. Best end lambs today topping out at 430p/kg from S M Ellingworth with super shape Beltex whilst first draw from Pritchard Farms 40kg to 404p/kg and E Brain & Sons 38kg to 401p/kg. S Harrison & Sons Ltd 40kg to 400p/kg. Smart shape from L G Russell & Son 392p/kg. Heavy shape in demand as more Butchers move to ringside. Super meat and shape from Young Farmer Harriett Hall, Atherstone seeing 51.5kg at 356p/kg and 51kg to 353p/kg. C R Hill down from Leicester to take 47kg at 353p/ kg and 49kg at 351p/kg. In the lump Export Lambs totting up to a massive £166 at only 43kg for C R Hill with Miss Harriett Hall 44kg to £165 and 42kg £162. MM Clarke & Sons 45kg £160 and S Harrison 40kg £160. In the lump heavies topping at £183.50 and £181.50 for Harriett Hall at 52.5kg with E J Taylor & Son 53kg £180.50 and Harriett Hall £180 at 51kg. Mark Lambert and MM Clarke & Sons £172. As numbers increase throughout the Nation a much improved quality of finish will be required throughout and Vendors are encouraged to move to Lambs weighing 40kg plus as small Lambs come out in force in the North.
