PRIME CATTLE: 35 HEAD

A mixed entry for quality and numbers, met a good enquiry from the Butchers and Wholesalers present, with a new customer unable to start due to numbers and trade. The smart handyweight cattle would easily be previous week's trade while the commercial cattle could be quoted 2-3p dearer in particular the heavyweight cattle. Bulls and cows would be quoted dearer on the week.

BULLS: 4 HEAD

Trade would be dearer on the week, with plain Holstein types between 123-128 ppk from Geoff Ratcliffe and grossing £740-£798. Continental's sold to £977.50 from Roundshill Farm.

STEERS:13 HEAD

An extremely mixed entry containing a lot of weight sold well and benefitted from strong demand from the ringside. Topping the section was a heavyweight Limousin from Terry Kennealy who sold others to 204ppk. Top price per head was £1296 from Hemel Hempstead, followed at £1274 from Nuthurst Heath Farm.

HEIFERS:18 HEAD

A nice entry of heifers, benefitted from the Butcher strength at ringside with each one purchasing cattle. The section and sale was topped at 213p for a quality Heifer from Terry Kennealy, who sold sisters at 210ppk. Peter Wilks sold a good trailer-load to 208ppk and averaged 201ppk for the load. Heavyweights sold to £1320 for the above heifer, grass-fed types sold to £1174.

A day of Surprises!! First of all the numbers forward with 3038 Lambs forward despite less than 1200 being booked in. This needs to be remedied and Vendors are required to book lambs. A simple answerphone message or text will suffice but lambs not booked in may have to be processed after those booked in. The second Surprise a monumental trade of 206p/kg SQQ equal to a deadweight equivalent of 4.35p/kg!!!! Merely a matter of the right time and right place to market sheep for the coming International Quarbani Celebration this weekend. It is likely that this is an unsustainable trade and reality likely to resume next week. Those who sold today though one for the diary. In the export lambs a real premium for best sorts seeing a top of 255p/kg for 38kg Beltex from H Collins & Son, Northampton ahead of IM Allen & Partners, Leicester at 42kg for Beltex to 249p/kg. Hillside Farm saw 33kg to 242p/kg with JB Elkington 38kg to 241p/kg. Heavies a real trade and meat rewarded throughout. Top PPK to the famous Humphrey Livestock seeing 46kg to 222p/kg whilst Tash Thurston 47kg at 218p/kg and BC Burton 47kg to 209p/kg. In the lump Euro weights to £106 for 45kg from Phil Darby Structures with Barbara and the lovely Tiff Hubbard at £104.50 for 42kg Beltex. Humphrey Livestock 43.5kg to £102.50.
