

Best cattle few and far between however Peter & Emma Jarrom still finding the goodens with an unbelievable bullock selling to 328ppk.

Josh Trivett topping the heifer pence per kilo with a homebred heifer at 308ppk.

The Trivett family again managing to top the lead grossing heifers at £1897.

WR Keeves topped the pounds per head on the steers with some fellas coming to £2058.

The Baxter family were back in town with some cracking bulls again selling to 293ppk or £2238.

Cows topped at 190ppk of £1702.

Again a lot of lean under finished on the Market. Sales pre-Christmas seemingly disappointingly slow and Buyers reporting a lack of interest in the commodity. Despite this an SQQ of 2.53p/kg equal to £5.60dw at best with some lambs now struggling to hit the 45% kill rate. Meat sadly short on supply. Better end lambs today to 300p/kg at 42kg for R Richins with 38kg from M Woodward to 299p/kg and DS & LE Wadland 41.5kg to 299p/kg. meat Export lambs regularly 270p/kg. Weight again better supported selling to 289p/kg at 48.5kg from SLAM Farming with proper Beltex from D Wadland to 56kg to 288p/kg and F Hodgkin 50.5kg to 287p/kg. D Redfern, Derby 276p/kg for 51kg. In the lump a top of £126 at 42kg from R Richins with Messrs Wadland 41.5kg to £124 and N Deeley 44 and 45kg at £123. Weight the favourite though selling to £167.50 at 64kg for Blue De maines from RFS Ltd, with Messrs Wadland 56kg at £161 and E Taylor 68kg at £152 and 60kg £150. Meat is the key but sadly also perhaps the key really is the need for Christmas demand to start to take off asap.

Lean grazers and lightweight Ewes hard to sell with the commodities only commanding a depleted value at the Shop Counter. Top today £192 for M Kellett with Texels and S Harrison & Son £181.50. Kellett again £180 to £178. Texel x regularly £140 plus. Suffolks to £150 for MJ Woodward and £147 for Minshull Farms and £140 for S Freeman. Suffolks generally £120 mark. Mules to £150 for a massive one off others £121 and £119.50. In general though Mules harder to sell and those short on weight or meat hard to cash. Lean grazers massively oversubscribed.
