Management Update

As you are all no-doubt aware the Market has been in negotiation in the last 18 months with regards to a proposed relocation.

Out of Courtesy and in response to spurious rumours erroneously made in recent weeks I hereby provide the following as an update.

In November the Joint Venture team of RFM and JLL achieved a grant of Planning Permission for the erection of a new Market site adjoining the A46, this was achieved at the first attempt and is seen as a positive.

The proposal is part of a private deal between RFM ltd and JLL and involves no other element of Compulsion insofar as RFM have no relationship whatsoever with HS2.

Negotiations as to the proposal continue as the Board aim to deliver a best case scenario for Shareholders, Market Users and for the future of the RFM Staff and on this basis are subject to Confidentiality Agreements.

To this end it is disappointing that malicious rumours have been made to the National Farming Press as to the mechanics of any negotiation that is in place. The details given are entirely incorrect. Any agreement that is reached will ensure complete continuity of this expanding prosperous Business.

I urge whomever it is that feels the need to act in this manner to refrain from doing so as its merely acts to jeopardise a marvellous opportunity for Market Users, Shareholders and the wider Agricultural Community.

Everything Is open and above board and anyone who has any dispute with this project that is a wonderful opportunity for the local farming community should be brave enough to discuss this with our Board of Directors at any time.

Notwithstanding the above progress continues to be made on the redevelopment project with some exciting progress being made towards the possibility of a new facility for use in the first half of next year.
