The only problem a 1000 at least short of requirements. Frankly Supply and Demand doing its thing again. Hoggs drying up and the big switch over completed. For these reasons an excess of demand whilst the Springers are yet to come forward. New Buyers in the aisles wanted to take lambs to the north but unable to fill the lorry. Sgg today to 255p/ kg including a variety of heavier lambs. Today 438 trading 260ppk and 300 lambs grossing over £110. In the Euro section a top ppk of 292p/ kg from MG & SM Grindal for 37kg ahead of pure Texels from S Wise at 290p/kg for 39kg whilst overnight lambs from W B Wrench saw 40kg at 285p/kg for Texels. In the heavies a top ppk of 271p/kg for 48kg stonking lambs from W B Wrench. Charollais from David Wilson saw 47kg to 264p/kg and whilst MM Clarke & Sons 45.5kg to 256p/kg and FJ Tombs & Son 46.5kg at equal money. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £118 for 44kg from Page Bros, £116.50 for 45kg from Richard Lowe and MM Clarke & Sons and £115 for 45kg from W B Wrench. Overall a top today of £130 for W B Wrench at 48kg with £127 for 54kg from Boulton Bros and £126 for RAE Wilson at 62kg. Trade trying to find its level and the current inflated trade if not sustainable, a welcome boost for Shepherds battling with Shearing and Strike.
