Another neat show of cattle meeting strong competition, where more could have been sold to vendors advantage. Meat as usual at a premium and shape and quality keenly pursued.

Bulls-3

3 handy Bulls today from G Ratcliffe, with Non-Assured Herefords selling to 185PPK, grossing \pm 1171, and Black and Whites to 160PPK, or \pm 908.

Steers-18

A mixed show of Steers forward today, with quality and meat rewarded well. Top PPK from Parry Walters selling Limousin x to 224PPK, with Richard Heckford selling to 204PPK. Top gross to Mr Heckford selling to £1358. "O" grading plainer types looking the trade of the day today seeing Hereford Steers to 204PPK from DP Jones.

Heifers-23

Simply stunning. Butchers and Wholesalers all competing for the best end. "O" grading sorts as ever looking a strong trade. Top PPK today shared between Pete Jarrom and Richard Fountaine, both seeing 239PPK for Limousin Heifers, with both being purchased by Carpenters Farm Shop. Our local butchers support us each week, please do your best to support them. Top gross today from Richard Fountaine selling Limousin x to £1525, with Parry Walters selling to £1416.

Cows-12

Only Non-Fabbl Cows forward today, but a fresh account opening up helping to bump trade on another notch. Overage Steers to 155PPK from MJ & IJ Gibbs, with top Cows to 135PPK from JS & N Morley, and a top gross for monster South Devons coming to £1177 from Rob Milner. More Cows are needed everyweek with Farm Assurance still important in this section.

A difficult entry on a sliding national calf trade. Best end in short supply and looking a nice trade, with reared sorts very mixy.

Best Continental Bulls as ever a strong trade and a pleasure to sell, topping at ± 322 from PS Hemming for Limousins, with best end Bulls all up of ± 250 .

Top Continental Heifers to ± 208 for Limousins, again from Messrs Hemming, with best types few and far between.

Rearing Continentals trading between £150 and £170 for Bulls, with Heifers £100-£140. Only two Native Calves forward and this is a desperate shame as more could have been sold to vendor advantage. Best Angus Bulls to £185 from KC & DA Hughes.

Dairy x Bulls a fair trade, with a bigger gap apparent between rearing sorts and processors. Top in the Bulls to R Jones and Son selling Fleckvieh Bulls to ± 127 .

Reared Calves seeing a trade of two halves. Younger Weanlings a nice trade, while older sorts harder to place. Top from R & AE Wallbank selling 5 Month old Blues to \pm 450. with others to \pm 405.

The bad Weather getting to grips with the numbers today to produce a small yarding that also seriously lacked meat and finish almost throughout. Trade a marvellous return for the quality on show and at 202p/kg a deadweight equivalent of £4.40p/kg without a grid some real trade. Best end still wanted and bid for throughout topping with Jean Herod at 244p/kg for 40.5kg and 239p/kg at 41kg from J B Elkington. Woody 40kg to 236p/kg and weight from Jean Herod 45kg to 236p/kg. Weight wanted today specific to finish with lean heavies lacking a customer base. Top 235p/kg at 46kg from Humphrey Livestock whilst meat from E Brain & Sons Ltd 47.5kg at 221p/kg and 218p/kg from J B Elkington. In the lump Exports up to £110 from D Gardiner at 40kg with £104 for 45kg from Jean Herod who also sold 40.5kg to £99. Overall a top today of half Nelson at £111 for 58.5kg from FJ Tombs & Son with 52kg from Messrs Hopcraft £110 and G Honour, Thame £110.
