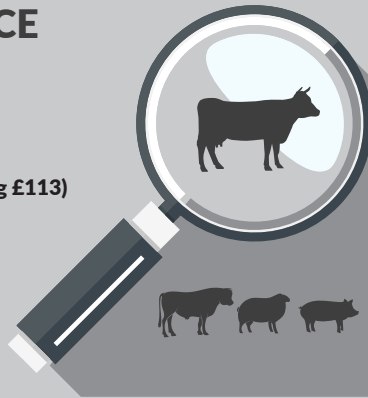

Trade nationally slipping on the day as numbers came out in force. The two tier trade now widening with best meat and heavy weight lambs finding a large audience. Vendors should note that lambs 38 to 43kg currently find a limited return with Export standard spec seeing limited Sales Nationally. An SQQ 252p/kg the highest in the Nation for the day a statement as to the buying power on show to buck the National trend. Our Thanks to them. Top today 314p/kg for Beltex at 42kg from B Nichols. W Bartlett up once again for properly finished Beltex lambs 39kg to 309 & 308p/kg and S Ellingworth 42kg 304p/kg. D W Gurney 300p/kg at 41kg. Heavies a top of 294p/kg at 49kg from D W Gurney & Son with 282p/kg for 50kg from MM Clarke & Sons and equal money for 49kg from Ted Taylor and 280p/kg for 50kg from S & C Farming down from Lichfield. An all in avg of £112 sees a movement of £1 per head up on the week. Export weights topping at £132 for 42kg from Ben Nichols with W Pearson & Son 45kg at £130 and S Ellingworth 42kg to £127.50. D Gurney 41kg at £123. Weight again the order of the day and vendors should look to draw weight as a preference. Top today 68kg from H L Goode & Sons at £163 with R Burman 58kg to £160 and Philly Batchelor, Judge supreme then controlling the leader board with 65kg at £156, 58kg at £155.50 and 65kg to £156. Lambs should be drawn for full finish with half meat Export lambs finding a limited trade.

Trade faltering nationally as numbers outstrip demand throughout the Country. Best end Ewes not out in force today but weighted Ewes to £180 for Texels from C W Lines with others £176 for L Cleave and Charolais £173 from RFS Ltd. White Faces with weight generally £160 plus. Suffolks to £158 for B Wilson and £150 for D Dashwood with the majority £135 plus. Mules hardest hit but topping at £128 for W Gaydon and £123 for J Weaver. Mules generally £112 mark for meated finish. Lean Ewes and grazers a marked decrease as are small Hill Ewes, with retail returns for such commodity seeing record lows on the Highstreet. Lean Ewes should be fed for best returns.

Home baking – Fruit Cake

Ingredients:

225g (8oz) S R Flour
1 tsp mixed spice
½ tsp ground cinnamon
½ tsp ground nutmeg
175g (6oz) butter
175g (6oz) soft brown sugar
1 tbsp black treacle
1 tsp each grated orange and lemon rind
4 eggs
550g (1 ¼ lb) mixed dried fruit
100g (4oz) chopped mixed peel
50g (2oz) glacé cherries
15ml milk

To finish:

Brandy to feed

Method:

Pre-heat the oven to 150°/300°F/Gas 2. Grease and line an 8in (20cm) deep round cake tin with a double layer of greased greaseproof paper.

Sift flour with spice, cinnamon and nutmeg.

Cream butter with sugar, treacle and orange and lemon rind.

Beat in eggs, one at a time, and adding 1 tbsp of sifted dry ingredients with each other. Stir in mixed fruit, chopped peel, and cherries.

Fold in dry ingredients alternately with milk.

Transfer to prepared tin and smooth top with a knife. Bake for 4 – 4 ½ hours or until a skewer comes out clean. Leave in tin for 15 minutes then turn out onto a wire cooling rack.

When cool, pierce the cake at intervals with a fine skewer and feed with a little brandy. Wrap the completely cold cake in a double layer of greaseproof paper and again in foil and store in a cool place for up to 3 months, feeding at intervals with more brandy.

Leave undecorated.
