CATTLE: 26 Forward

PRIME CATTLE: 26 Head

A harvest entry, with lots of vendors either combining or baling straw in the excellent dry weather and several worried about the change in weather forecast at the end of the week. Those vendors that did bring stock were rewarded with an improved trade from a full ring of buyers and say averages dearer by 3p on the week.

PRIME BULLS: 4 Head.

Numbers remain tight but extra orders at ringside pushed trade dearer on the week. An entry of solely dairy bred animals sold to a top of 191p for a lightweight blue from Richard Heckford, MBE. Black and whites sold to 190 from Manor farm with same having top price per head of £1079.70.

PRIME STEERS:13 Head.

A mixed entry for breed and quality saw all types in demand and strong buyer presence at ringside with several new orders present all types met an improved trade in particular dairy types. A superb heavyweight Limousin from John Wrench topped the section and sale at 227p per kilo, with others 221p from the Thomas family again for heavyweights. Dairy breds sold to 194p for fleck-crosses from Geoff Walker. Grass Herefords sold to 180p from Pete Betteridge and the top price per head been £1414.40 from Ces and family.

PRIME HEIFERS:9 Head.

Super trade for all forward, top price was 219p for a special from Parry Walters who's wagon load averaged 217p per kilo. Ces and Family sold a Blue Cross to 218p, natives sold to 189p for a heavyweight black heifer from Messrs Parrott. Heavyweight heifers topped at £1294.30 and £1263-63 from Parry Walters. Grass Heifers sold to £1165.90 from Pete Betteridge with Herefords.

PRIME LAMBS: 1156 Forward SQQ 186p/kg

The lowest yarding in numbers for quite some time with vendors struggling for meat and others closed up from buying breeders. Trade brisker and returning an SQQ of 186p/kg representing a deadweight comparison of 404p/kg. Lambs looking to be suffering in the weather and as a result not the meat on show. In the Euro lambs a dearth of shape but those with it topping at 221p/kg and 220p/kg from R Richins, Oxford with Beltex. Di Hopcraft continued her show of quality with 44kg to 200p/kg and Steve and Elaine Friswell 40kg to 199p/kg. In the heavies a top of 194p/kg from B C Burton at 47kg with another penfull at 190p/kg equal with Ted Taylor. In the lump Euro lambs today lacking finish on the whole and vendors are encouraged to now feed to ensure finish. 40kg to £88.50 from Messrs Richins and equal from Di Hopcraft. Overall £118 top from B C Mawby with 68kg with the same home showing 60kg to £109 and Ted Taylor 59.5kg to £102.50 with Harrison Bros 56kg to £100.50. Trade still sluggish but numbers slowing nationally meaning buyers having to concentrate to ensure they have something to kill unlike past weeks where buyers have had more supply nationally than they can market.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCMENT

With the religious festival now imminent on the 21st of August, we make preparations for those that wish there stock to qualify for the various requirements of the festival. For this reason, the following Mondays until the Festival date we will pen all ram lambs separately and denote them as the same. Equally, this year will see a more stringent control upon the age of the lambs slaughtered. On this basis we will be asking all farmers whom wish to confirm the age of their lambs to complete a declaration at the time of sorting. This will need to be fully authorised and signed for by the registered owner if they wish to partake.
