All about weight today with rows of heavy Steers forward. Some coming forward too lean today and Christmas not the market for cattle short on finish. Trade harder on the week albeit those with cover well chased. Some very lean overage cattle today definitely better sold in the Store cattle.

Steers;

All heavyweights in the main seeing a top for mediums with cover from Richard Ellis at 260p/kg for Angus Steers with Blues from N J Foster 257 and 255p/kg F Hogkin 250p/kg. O+ Steers over 222p/kg but today this area of trade needing more cover. Gross top £1936 from W R Keeves & Son, Yardley Gobian with R F & J Nichols £1834.

Heifers;

More finish in this section seeing a sweet heifer with plenty of weight from Messrs Trivett take 282p/kg and others 280p/kg. Finish from CJ Clayton saw 269p/kg with R Ellis 242p/kg. R Grades trading 230 to 240p/kg and O+ Grades trading well into 230p/kg mark if finished. Top gross £1856 to Messrs Trivett and £1815 to R F & J Nichols.

Bulls;

Extreme Holsteins on parade today seeing 190p/kg and 183p/kg for Messrs Barnett but topping out at £1216..

A full yarding towards 2500 and not the day for a Computer breakdown at 9.30am. Our thanks to peoples patience but I am sure all will understand that machines however new breakdown sometimes. Trade though surely made up for it with local deadweight quotes of £6 made to look laughable when an SQQ of 292p/kg posted for a yarding of wet lambs that did not posses depth in quality. Fed lambs well rewarded but some lambs very much a step only above Stores only in terms of finish. Those with finish on fire, saw Smart Beltex 332p/kg from Chiltern Beltex with 44kg 330p/kg from J & H Tustian, Epwell whilst 42kg 329p/kg from Messrs Chiltern Beltex. City weight lambs from J Rutter & Son saw 33.5kg to 319p/kg. Weight still in vogue and finish a real demand. Top in the weight of 306p/kg at 49kg from C R Hill, Leicester. B C Burton 48kg to 302p/kg and C R Hill also 48kg to 301p/kg. R Woodward 46kg to 300p/kg. Rows of light weight lambs today and heavies short on supply but still an all in avg of £129. In the lump Export lambs topping out at £145 for 44kg from Messrs Tustian. Chiltern Beltex saw 42kg to £138 with R Woodward 45kg to £137. Top gross today saw weight well chased by all buyers topping at £170 for 72kg from MJ & J Taylor, Fillongley. FJ Tombs & Son £166 at 56kg with A Cook, Bristol equal alongside Messrs Taylor again with 92 lambs trading over £155. Again a phenomenal trade and numbers likely to raise there heads throughout the week. Next week will be a week when leaner lambs will find a reduced trade due to Christmas and Vendors should only show the very fit lambs. Thanks again for everyone's patience and rest assured the IT Company will be working on the infrastructure all week.

SATURDAY 4TH DECEMBER



Saturday saw the Dispersal of the Entire flock from D & E Mitchell, Nuneaton, whom are relocating to retire to Cornwall. The inlamb sale was hosted prior to the Seasonal Small holders sale alongside other entries. Those that did not turn up missed out on a large audience of buyers and we apologise to those that arrived for the Mules that did not turn up.

Those that did enjoyed huge returns. OE Mould, Rushden set the tone with the first pen of Blue Texels Double Theaves scanned at 167% took £222 before the same sold a large pen of Suffolk FM at 171% to take £190. On into the Dispersal and a large interest in these genuine sheep saw brisk bidding from the start. With the oldest sheep looking the dearest, buyes seemed to favour experience in the lambing shed. First into the ring saw FM Pure Texels at 125% take £260, Beltex then saw FM to £232 for a couple of pens. 6 Tooth Ewes shot up to £258 for Beltex carrying 180% whilst Charolais x bred by David Wadland saw £258 for 160% with Texels at the same rate to £232. Double Theaves next seeing pens of Beltex at 150% to £300 and £290 at 180% before a lone star, Dave's favourite Beltex, strolled into the ring scanned to doubles taking £360 sold to Nicolas Freeman.

Shearlings next topping at £295 with others £294 scanned to doubles. Next we addressed the Sheep too far off for counting lambs these topped at £226 for FM Beltex. As to recognise the families breeding we then sold the Shearlings scanned clear of the Tup to take £175 and Ewe lambs clear of the Tup to £140. An all in Sale avg of £230 showing quality of Stock as well as Confidence in the future of the Sector.
