

Today no barn storming trade but a definite feel that for the first time in months, Supply and Demand may be reaching parity in opposition to the previous state of a mass over Supply nationally. An Sqg of 249p/kg a marked move forward and without deadweight Compare. Export Weight Hoggs the flavour of the day and more interest than we have been seeing. Heavy Hoggs remain a hard sell with London Wholesale trade very Slow. Top today the last Lady standing when Leah Dallow sold City Hogg full meat to 315p/kg with 35kg Beltex from Passmore & Nunnerley 277p/kg and J Duggins, Derbyshire Charolais at 272p/kg. A Mitchell 40kg to 270p/kg. Heavies a harder trade selling to 255p/kg for 47kg for R Woodward and 252p/kg for 48kg for RFS Ltd. F H Everett & Sosn 50kg to 250p/kg. An all in avg of £109 today the real headline when you equate what weight in Carcass is needed to hit this figure on National deadweight quotes. In the lump Exports topping at £115 for 45kg for S Leedham with F A Walker 44kg to £112 and White Bros 45kg to the same. Milkwood Farms up from Newbury saw 45.5kh at £111.50. Heavies a hard trade but as is the season soe real weight about. Top today £150 for 75kg from P Edwards and 73kg for RFS £143. G Tew, Crok saw 61.5kg to £138 and H Goode & Son 65kg to £138. We hope for more Sales on the Continent and a return to Pub Menus domestically in the Month of Meaty March.


