A massive surprise to see such a short number when considering the monumental trade we have been witnessing. Many more needed next week.

Steers:

Smart feeding the top today with expertly finished Cattle from N J Foster 275p/kg at U- but fed to the exact spec of the current demand with plenty of weight at 736kg. Again another perfectly finished beast from P Jarrom seeing 266.5p/kg with heavy weights at 250p/kg from N J Foster. Nice to see Kingston Blount Farms show a Blue Steer to 243.5p/kg and R grades all well over 236p/kg with best fed 240p/kg. Weights pays and N J Foster entering the elite club passing £2000 at £2024 with weight once again from W R Keeves at £1897 and £1874.

Heifers;

Same remarks apply to the top beast at 275p/kg from P Jarrom with 266p/kg at 566kg from J Jackson, Market Bosworth and 264p/kg from J Peebles, Shipston on Stour. J Jackson also 260p/kg. R Grades to 240p/kg. O+ 230p/kg plus. In the lump a top of £1685 from John Peebles with J Jackson £1597 and £1559. A wealth of buyers for Butchers Heifers and a massive demand for next week.

Bulls;

Again no numbers but a massive trade with O+ fed Bulls from Alan Tacy to 235p/kg and £1357.

A lift in numbers back to over 2000 with the wagons from the East rolling in on Sunday night to see the lairage with 900 overnight Hoggs. Not a yarding of supreme breeding but more meat on show albeit a percentage that are woefully under finished and perhaps best given another chance. Meat rewarded throughout and a real trade for Hoggs today and a return of 280p/kg well ahead and top of the tree for the day nationally. Demand strongest for best end Hoggs with heavies a surprising lift in trade throughout. Top today an extreme Beltex from M & C Morris 347p/kg at 36kg with D Oakes, Derby 344p/kg and D W Gurney 39kg at 340p/kg with W Bartlett, Buckingham 39.5kg at 338p/ kg. D W Gurney 40kg 330p/kg. Shaped Export weights all above 300p/kg but standardised Hoggs under 43kg trading regularly 2.90p/kg. Middle weights harder to sell as they fall between specs with City weights very dear. In the weighted Hoggs a massive move for weight as Irish demand sparked up on Monday morning for supply to North African regions. Passmore and Nunnerley 49kg to 327p/kg for super meat with K Crabtree 51kg at 322p/kg and Tommy Tustians run of 170 topping at 321p/kg for 49kg and Poulson & Co super Charolais at 47.5kg to 308p/kg. Export Hoggs topping at 45.5kg at £144.50 for super Beltex from W Bartlett with 44kg at £140 on two occasions from Tommy Tustian. A huge movement in trade for the Heavy Hoggs with the Mobile phones ringing 10 mins into the Sale to give the order for greater demand. Shape again the order of the day as where the meat. Shape and finish a top of £164 for 51kg from J P Page & Son with Poulson & Co 56kg to £163.50 and Passmore & Nunnerley 49kg to £160 with RFS Ltd 56.5kg at £159.50. Trade very pleasing albeit Sales still limping along in Europe. Meat is the key and Vendors are encouraged to ensure Hoggs are fully finished.
