Friday 4th May Store Cattle: 293 Forward

A surprising entry of store cattle for our first May sale. Starting with breeders saw a strong Limousin cow and calf from Steve Timms selling to £2010 for a '12 plate cow. In-calf heifers from A Dickin saw British Blue x heifers, PD'd in-calf to a Hereford to £840 at 21 months. Into the stores which saw DT & D Mann & Son sold Saler x steers to £770 at 10 months of age. C Cummins & Son sold British Blue x steers to £810 at 13 months with RJ Wright selling Limousin x steers to £895 at 10 months. N Hague & Sons sold Limousin x steers to £1020 at 14 months with other from the same home to £990. Messrs Ibbetson & Crawley sold Simmental x steers to £1000 at 17 months, with heifers from the same stable to £900.
