With Ramadan Eid only a matter of hours away the numbers held back with only half a buying team in attendance. Numbers matched demand and Buyers frantic to take meat straight back to kill with an SQQ of 402p/kg which would have been higher other than a real quantity of lean Hoggs throughout with some producers rushing a product not yet ready. Meat a real premium throughout. Top today 560p/kg at 40kg for Blue Texel shape from AF Neal with Beltex to 530p/kg at 43kg from GR Fountaine & Son 43kg at 530p/kg with M & C Morris 500p/kg at 42kg and GR Hallifield 44kg at 472p/kg. Best end trading regularly 420p/kg mark plus. Export Hoggs meated and finished 400p/kg plus with meat Romneys past 410p/kg. Lean also ran Export Weight 370p/kg – 380p/kg. Heavies a real trade and topping at 483p/kg for 46kg from P & LA Gibbs with GR Fountaine 50kg to 470p/kg also at 47kg. Messrs Hallifield Farmers 460 to 465p/kg 46 to 52kg. An all in Avg of £184. Export Hoggs to massive £228p/kg at 43kg with GR Fountaine & Son with 40kg to £225 for A F Neal and GR Fountaine 44kg to £220 with Messrs Hallifield 44kg to £210. Weight continues to pay and a top of £241 at 57.5kg for GR Fountaine & Son with the same home 52kg at £240. NF & K Redfern sold proper meat at 63.5kg £237 and Hallifield Farms 54kg to £235.




