

Numbers Building with 383 today. Quality fairly variable and those over fat and spuriously bred a much harder sell. Fresh full Spring lambs though in good demand to see and SQQ of 360p/kg. Best End lambs to 408p/kg for P Cobley at 38kg with 42.5kg also 400p/kg. RDG Taylor 395p/kg at 40kg and Messrs Hallifield 38.5kg to 384p/kg. Spring lambs with bloom 365p/kg plus. Heavies to 400p/kg for 48kg from P Cobley with 48kg from J & R Lowe 48kg to 371p/kg and MM Clarke & Sons 46kg to 370p/kg. In the Lump Export Lambs to £170 at 42.5kg for Messrs Cobley whilst D Dashwood 44kg to £169.50 equal with MM Clarke & Sons. Overall a top of £192 at 48kg for P Cobley with 59kg to £189 for R Tofield and £180 52kg for MM Clarke & Sons. Lambs need to be fully finished with City trade for Spring Lambs unusually slow this year.
