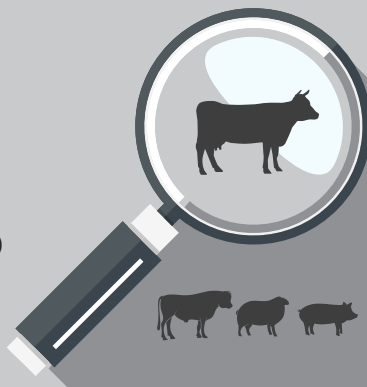

WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

Numbers tighter than expected with towards 2000 expected from those booked in but vendors either locked up on the weekend through Blue Tongue or simply not finding the meat they expected.

Trade should be noted as beyond our widest dreams with the end of last week trading at the 270p/kg mark and deadweights still dropping. Despite all this and a few Buyers not turning up with there own reports of slow Sales.

Best meat in hot demand and a better yard of meat appreciated by all in attendance. Best end shape and fed from DS & LA Wadland saw 40kg Beltex at 390p/kg with lovely Rouge from A K Wilson 369p/kg and Messrs Fountaine 44kg at 364p/kg. Messrs Wadland also 350p/kg at 44kg equal with R Richins. Export quality all trading 300p/kg plus with fed first cross also 300p/kg plus. Leaner lambs trading 290 - 300p/kg th very lean Store lambs 270 - 290p/kg. Heavies remain easy to sell despite catering trade seeing loss leaders floated in London. Topping at 348p/kg at 46.5kg for Messrs Wadland with 47kg 332p/kg for Fountaines's and weight and shaoe at 53kg from Hyde Lane Farms 321p/kg. Plenty of weight over 300p/kg but common mid weights 47 - 50kg a steadier trade with margins tightened to destruction point.

An all in Avg over £140 now stretches for month after month and as a result Vendors can only be pleased with Lamb trade. Sales though harder and we hope our Salesmen at the World food Conferance this week do us proud.

Export lambs today topping at £146 at 44kg for B Burton with A Wilson 43kg to £145 equal with BF Humphries & Sons. Weight though pays and £180 for 59.5kg for T Wood with overweights 83kg for P F Edwards £180. AR & J Collett fresh back from the working mens clubs of Yorkshire saw 61kg to £178 and Hyde Lane Farms 58kg at £174.

More needed but simply put meat must be the key.

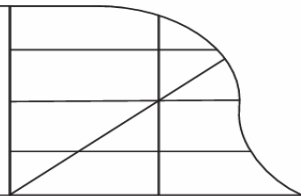

A similar number but a terribly poor yarding in quality with most too lean to graze.. Lean middle weight Ewes a good trade but few and far between. Fat a better trade on the week.

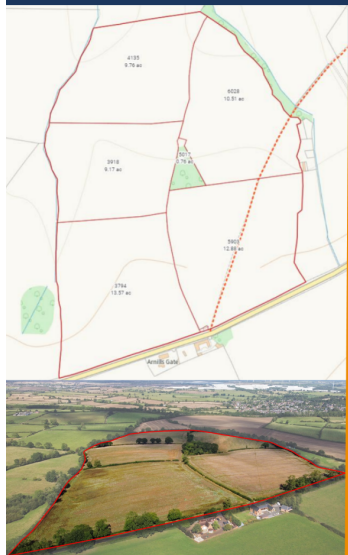
