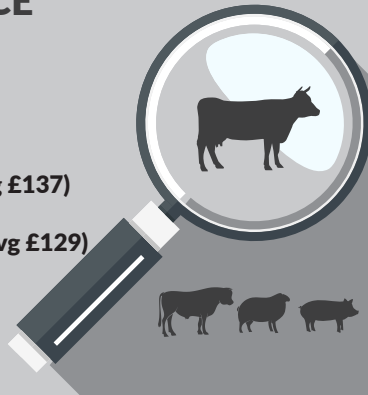

Numbers building as Spring Lambs come to be drawn. In truth quality not what we would expect at this time of year and many lambs looking to have struggled through the dry Spring and many lambs today Mule bred and short of stature. Trade though very very dear with an SQQ of 346p/kg a marvellous return and the majority of Lambs 40kg and under trading well past 350p/kg. Those lambs 41kg to 47kg at a much decreased demand and Vendors urged to produce handy weight lambs 36 to 40kg or heavier lambs over 47kg. A real trade throughout from start to finish and buyers currently very specific in wanting handyweights seeing plenty of lighter lambs trading 380p/kg mark and deadweight today would see the yarding avg of 720p/kgdw. Shape the Butchers choice and top of the tree today for lambs carrying bloom from J T Owen, Wolverhampton saw 37.5kg at 395p/kg whilst S Harrison & Sons Ltd, Evesham took 37kg at 392p/kg with Pete Cobley 39kg at 390p/kg and M Houghton 32kg at 388p/kg. Over 44.5kg a steadier trade selling to 318p/kg at 46.5kg from SA & E Frsiwell with son Stuart 48kg to at equal money and JR Baxter & Smith 46kg at 317p/kg. In the lump a marvellous yard avg of a whopping £137!!! Top today £161 for P Cobley at 42kg whilst H Faulkner & Sons £157.5 at 44kg and S Friswell 43kg at £155.50. Lamb trade will now become more choosy on grade and Lambs should be pushed hard for meat with those lambs drawn under 41kg only if they are fully meat. Please do not draw just to weight ensure lambs are fully finished.
