Butchers seemingly short and despite the generality of poor cattle a flying trade. In the Steers a top of 226p/kg from Richard and Judy Fountaine ahead of P Steels at 220p/kg and 214p/kg from the Fountaines. Top gross though to £1571 from Messrs Fountaine for a homebred beast.

Heifers as ever wanted and selling to 225p/kg for P Steels at 597kg ahead of Angus from Ralph Tustian at 222p/kg and Messrs Fountain 212p/kg. Top gross to £1344 from P Steels with £1308 to Ralph Tustian.

Cattle clearly wanted and buyers doing there bit. More finish though please ladies and gentlemen.

In the Cows today some 50-60 month Steers from Messrs Busby selling to 170p/kg and £1240. A real appetite for such goods with end users glad to see the age and wanting Cows. Cows also a fast trade selling to 171p/kg for Peter Amor. Aged Cows to 142p/kg from P Steels returning £1119.

SHEEP:4072

Prime Lambs: 1823 Forward SQQ 180p/kg

As the trade lifts so do numbers with well over 1800 lambs today again meeting a smart trade. Quality not in the same league as last week and some lambs rushed forward. That said an SQQ of 1.80 very attractive in contrast to the alternative with lambs dying over 3.90p/kgdw. Lambs with finish often taking 190 to 200p/kg. In the Euro spec lambs a top ppk of 210p/kg for 40kg from Bob Tofield ahead of 45kg at 204p/kg from H P Read and 202p/kg for a 42kg from Bob Tofield. 200p/kg for Page Bros at 40kg. in the heavies a real sort from Page Bros at 49kg at 200p/kg whilst pens full from H L Goode 49.5kg at 187p/kg and BMF Smith 186p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £92 for 45kg from HP Read whilst Bob Tofield £85 for 42kg and Page bros 44kg at £84.5. Overall weight paying today as long as they were over the 49kg mark. Top of £102 for RF & J Nichols at 57kg whilst E J Taylor £100.50 for 56kg and H L Goode and G Fountaine £100 at 55kg. Trade will now all depend on numbers. This should be monitored week to week
