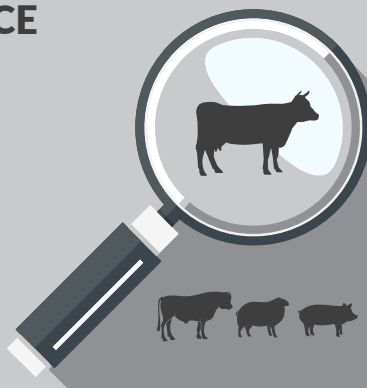

Numbers seriously short as Vendors struggle for meat. Those with the commodity though a serious trade throughout with an SQQ of 272p/kg equal to £5.85 Dw!!! Butchers taking a grasp of the Nettle and leaving Exporters in their wake. Meat a real trade throughout and the only negative today the lack of numbers. Some very lean lambs about and they are now discounted up to 30p/kg as the Export market becomes much more choosy. Top today saw Pete Bodily to 338p/kg and 328p/kg for 43kg Beltex just pipping the Hauliers GR Fountaine & Son at 317p/kg before DS & La Wadland showed proper fed meat at 45kg to 316p/kg and 40-42kg 314-315p/kg. 7% of today's yard hitting 300p/kg. Weight again the most wanted as lack of Meat and Export trade falls away. Weighted lambs to 318p/kg at 49kg from DS & LA Wadland with super breeding and feeding also seeing 47kg at 313p/kg and 50kg at 310p/kg. PJ East 50kg to 310p/kg and FJ Tombs 52kg to 304p/kg. Export weights to massive gross figures seeing 45kg to £142 for DS & LE Wadland, P Bodily 43kg to £141 and C Stubbs 45.5kg to £138 today 144 Lambs trading over £130. Top gross today saw £165 at 70kg for Suffolks from JF Fyfe & Nephew for overnight Suffolks. £162 for David Wadland showing he can do it at all weights at 58kg. £162 for 55.5kg from FJ Tombs & Son with HL Goode & Son 62kg at £161 then five other pens also at £160.

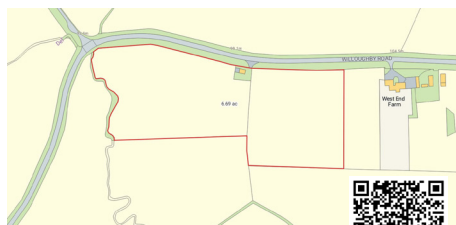

13th December 2023



From 13th December 2023, all producers selling livestock for slaughter will require a Veterinary Attestation, or evidence of membership of a qualifying assurance scheme.
