Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

CATTLE : 63 Forward



The show was slightly tighter, with fewer top-quality cattle forward, but trade reached the highest prices seen yet. Six cattle sold for over 400ppk, with Tom Reeve's stunning Limousin Heifer leading the way at 419ppk.

Other excellent Heifers followed closely, with prices of 414ppk and 407ppk from JC & AT Hutchinson. Steers peaked at 400ppk from Frank Page.

The top Steer from Robert Nichols fetched a massive £3457, while the top Heifer sold for £3175 - an incredible trade!

Butchers and Wholesalers were short on numbers to meet demand. Young Bulls reached 362ppk, or £2667, from Richard Lowe.

R R & M Lawrence topped the Cows at 283ppk, or £2609

Store Cattle - 13th February



To see is to believe!! A new Centre record for genuine Stores from H L Goode at £2490 for Angus Steers.

We all knew they would be dear with the continued and unprecedented increase in Fat Cattle returns. But buyers were two deep, and any trade was simply blistering, with £4/kg been and gone on the quality cattle, and plenty at 4.20 plus.

Starting with Cows and Calves, we saw new vendor E Boden & Sons, Droitwich, sell a Cow and Calf Couple Piedmontese to £3120. The 7-year-old cow, being free of the bull, sold with their 10-month-old bull calf.

Feeding bulls were flying, with NF & K Redfern selling Limousin 7-month-old bulls to £1410 and £1250. Townshends sold Blonde bulls to £1255.

Popular calf-rearing expert Mark Peebles kicked us off, selling Lim x Steers at 5 months for £905, with sisters at £820. Herefords, suckler bred from Gloucestershire, from R J White, saw 11-13 month-old steers at £1355 and £1220. NF & K Redfern, with genuine red Limousin quality, saw a top of £1595 for 9-10 month-old steers, with others at £1585, £1550, and £1500. Proper outwintered stores from Wolverton Farm Estates saw £1450 for Simmental steers at 11 months, and sisters at £1000. Pritchard Farms sold their best run so far, with Limousin steers at 10 months reaching £1665 and £1485, with sisters at £1160. Cornwall calling next, with Brendans selling Charolais steers at 19 months for £1605 and 11-month-old brothers for £1360. C McMillan, down from Cheshire, sold proper traditional Blues from Dairy Shorthorns, seeing heifers at 16 months for £995. Then the strength from K Allard stole the show for the youth, seeing 12-month-old Limousin steers to £1900, with others at £1710 and £1700. Dairy men reaped the rewards also when moving up the ages, with Limousin steers from P Dyson at 16 months selling for £2020 and 14 months for £1555.

R S Beaty & Sons, with the first of their seasonal draws, saw a top of £2190 for super Simmentals at 19 months, with others at £2070, £1940, and £1900.

Then, H L Goode & Sons, Solihull, stole the show, selling 35 Angus and Shorthorns to an average of £2070. These Angus, 19-21 month-old steers, saw a top of £2490, with others at £2425 and £2405. Shorthorns reached £2300, with heifers at £2045.

Strength from Woods Farm Meridan saw £2200 and £2005 for Simmental heifers at 20 months. Buckets next, with Lim x from T J Hoare selling steers at £1745 at 21 months, and Angus in pen after pen at £1520, £1505, and £1500. Sisters better done, selling to £1580 and £1490. R J White then with his older groups saw heifers at £1665 at 23 months.

To round things off, one last new customer from Hampshire saw Heckfield Estates sell Blue Bucket steers at 27 months for £2000 and £1900.

Many, many more wanted next week.

SQQ 360P/KG AVG £154.97. TOP £215 for K Crabtree

Painfully short on numbers for a Sale, which saw a flying trade for Exports and an improved trade for heavies. An SQQ of 360p/kg absolutely flying, with all corners wanting Export Hogs and good finished Hogs in massive demand.

Top of the day: real shape from MJ Woodward at 39kg to 431p/kg, with Henry Tustian breaking cover for the Root feeders to sell 38.5kg at 429p/kg, equal with Steve Timms. 425p/kg was also taken by Henry and R Richins Beltex, with weight and grade, seeing 45kg at 424p/kg and 420p/kg. Plenty of Hogs over 400p/kg today, and trade just simply flying for those with fully finished Hogs.

Meated Exports with style: 380-420p/kg. Meat-first cross: 350-380p/kg, with lean Hogs trading around the 340-350p/kg mark. Heavier Exports were discounted by 10p for those over 43.5kg. Weight with meat was chased hard throughout.

Weighted Beltex from S F Taylor: 48kg at 417p/kg, equal for the same from R Richins, also selling 47kg at 403p/kg. K Crabtree had 48.5kg at 400p/kg, with others at 390p/kg.

All in average of £155 today, with weighted Exports making a massive £191 for 45kg from R Richins and £183 for H Tustian. £181 for 44kg from R Richins, with plenty of export Hogs £160 plus.

Top overall: £215 at 57kg for Beltex from K Crabtree, sold to Yorkshire Halal Meats. R & T Reeve next at £207 for 63kg and £207 at 60kg for Team Crabtree. H L Goode & Son, fresh from Thursday's Store Cattle, high selling to £205.50. S Taylor, R Richins, and P Edwards all breaking £200.

Trade was simply sharp throughout, and meat needs to be sold. Many more numbers are desperately needed.

Henry Tustian had heavy Texels at £280, and Z Collett had Texel x at £272. Continental Ewes with weight traded at 220 plus. Tex x Mules ranged from £180-220.


