A two-tier trade, meat and handy weight Hoggs, absolutely flying, whilst weight Hoggs hit the barriers to see Export Hoggs worth more than weight, with an all-in average of £157!

Export and small City trade firing, with a ring full of buyers on show throughout. Shape and meat hit 421p/kg from Harrison Bros, with real shape Beltex, before Winslow's finest saw AEJ & FJ Claridge's 40.5kg Texels at 405p/kg, and Harrison Bros' 40kg at 404p/kg. K Crabtree had 43.5kg Beltex Hoggs at 400p/kg. RF & J Nichols, MP Carter, Harrison Bros, Claridge, and R Kellett all hit 400p/kg. Best meat with shape ranged from 380 – 421p/kg. Meated second draw traded from 360 – 380, and lean Hoggs were trading at 340p/kg plus unless outrightstores were trading at the 330p/kg mark.

Heavies in general had a very hard sale, although meat still shone. The top price was 49kg at 410p/kg for Paul Baker, who came over from Lincolnshire. K Crabtree's Beltex 47kg sold at 391p/kg and 50kg at 384p/kg. D W Morley had 47kg at 383p/kg, and Crabtree's 51kg sold at 376p/kg.

In the lump, Exports were fantastic throughout, with the top price at £176 for 44.5kg from Kieth Crabtree. He also sold 43.5kg at £174 and 44kg at £170. Robert and Jenny Nichols had 42.5kg at £170, and John and Mike Eadon sold 45kg at £170.

Weight was hard to shift, but weight with shape was rewarded, reaching a top of £204 at 63kg from K Crabtree. Paul Baker's 49kg sold at £201, and K Crabtree's 55kg sold at £200. Generally, weight Hoggs traded at weight plus £120 throughout.

The dearest yet. All buyers on parade, and all agreeing that they are the dearest they had ever seen, trading at an all-in average of £166, with a run of Shetland Ewes included.

A very proud moment today as the Ewes topped by the youngest of young farmers, Mr. Douglas David Doody, selling Charolais x Beltex at £261. Texels from S M Ellingworth sold at £258 and £246, with Charolais from Harrison Bros at £234. Pen after pen of weighted sheep broke £200, with Texels trading between £200 – £230. Texel Mules were trading regularly at £185 plus. Suffolks reached £213 from S & J Farming, with Dougie Doody at £210, equal with Humphrey Livestock. Weight generally hovered either side of £200. Mules topped at £195 and £190 from M Fox, AW & G Rigby, RJ Wright, and A Dobin. Plenty of Mules today were trading at £170 and over.

Simply mad, and Ewes every bit as dear as overweight Hoggs. Sadly, the two commodities are quite different on the shop counter.
