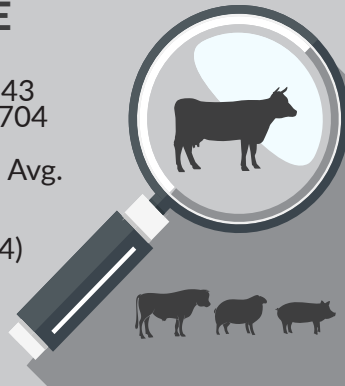

Steers-

A sharp show of steers forward, with some real class amongst the entry. Topping the tree saw Robert and Tom Reeve seeing fantastic South Devons to 428p/kg, with the same home to 424p/kg for Limousins. DTP Walkers & Partners saw Limousins to 421p/kg just pipping Richard Lowe to 416p/kg.

Top grossing steers saw Richard Lowe with purebred Limousins to £2942.72 at just 18 months! A lorry load of heavyweights up from Essex saw DJ Hull & Partners selling to a top of £2893.40 for dairy bred Blues, with Angus from the same stable to £2847.92.

Heifers-

Parry Walters saw a top of 426p/kg for handy weighted Limousin types, with PM Jarrom seeing 419p/kg ahead of J Collins seeing Limousins to 418p/kg and 415p/kg.

Heifers in the lump topping at £2704.00 for Parry Walters with the same home to £2666.76, ahead of dairy bred Angus from the Hull stable topping at £2571.14.

Hoggs;

More about but feeders still reporting numbers hard to find with many booking 150-200 in provisionally only to find a lot less fit than hoped. A yarding short on quality this week as conditions seem not be favouring Hoggs not yet shown a hopper. Trade though very very fast with all accounts firing and keen for numbers giving an improved SQQ on the week of 371p/kg despite a lesser yarding in quality. Ramadan closing at the end of week and Exporters keen to get stock into Europe for the festivities. Top today 481p/kg at 42kg from R Richins, Oxford with Beltex ahead of G & E Livestock at 471p/kg for a pen of 14 Beltex with Laban Partners 466p/kg for Beltex and 45kg from P J East 448p/kg for proper Beltex shape. Plenty of Hoggs over 400p/kg today. Export weight Root or Hopper Hoggs trading 380 - 420p/kg with general meat exports 360 - 380p/kg and leaner and first cross 350p/kg plus. Lean Store sorts trading 340 upwards. Weight remains harder to sell throughout the country. Shape and weight can still be well sold as Exporters will take such commodity and on this basis H Tustian selling 46kg to 426p/kg and W J Prime, Derbyshire 46kg at 413p/kg with G & E Livestock, Norfolk 46kg at 409p/kg. Messrs Pugh and Laban over 400p/kg also. Weight in general though seeing no advantage in gross between 46kg to 52kg with home trade and processing trade very steady. Heavy Hoggs trading generally 320p/kg mark with Lean under 300p/kg.

In the lump Export Hoggs trading to a massive £202 for R Richins at 42kg with P J East 45kg 448p/kg and J & H Tustian 44kg at £192 with Laban Partners and Richins also breaking £190. An all in Avg of £157.90 a real strong return when very few heavies add to the Avg that said the Export trade simply a wonderful return for Farmers. Heavies to a top overall of £204 for 55kg from J & H Tustian. With plenty trading in the £190's to £180's.

More Hoggs needed in the coming weeks as Export Hoggs dry up.

More ewes forward and a proper show of quality, with more weight about than we have seen for several weeks.

Best end Continental ewes today saw purebred Texels from J & H Tustian selling to £342, with AD & RM Thomas with heavy Charollais ewes to a top of £310, matching Josh & Tyson Nunnally for Texel ewes. Extreme Beltex from the Tustian stable sold to £302 with RM Calcott to £301 for Texels, just pipping the Norfolk Wanderer AA Peck. Weighted Continentals on the whole £220-£240 with $\frac{3}{4}$ bred types £250-£270.

Medium sorts around the £200 mark with leaner lighter weight ewes £160-£180. Suffolks topping at £240 for heavyweights from AA Peck, with the same stable selling to £233, just pipping Nigel Redfern at £232. Suffolks with weight actively over £200, with leaner sorts £150-£170.

Mules with weight roaring away to a top of £200 from RAE Wilson, with H Smith & Son selling to £193. C Naylor and Nigel Redfern both sold to £190 for Mules with Wendy Taylor to £187.

Lean, light and shelly ewes valued accordingly however every ewe on the yard today averaging £171.94.

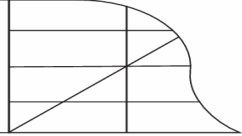
