A real Buzz around the Market today with Pens full of Cattle travelling from South Cornwall throughout the Midlands and into Norfolk. Buyers very appreciative of the number forwards and in big demand.

Breeders kicked us off at speed with C H Evans selling Simmental Cows 2021 with a 3m old Calf selling to £2900 before the last of the Heart of England Dispersal made a mockery of Official Sales when seeing his Pedigree Limousin Cow & Calf units top out at £4500 for a 2013 Registered Cow with her 5m old Bull Calf at foot. The Farms others seeing a 2016 unit with a 10m Heifer at foot sell to £4200. Both Empty. Later the same good home saw a 18m Bulling Heifer sell to a massive £3300!!!!!

Feeding Bulls a plenty and 60 Sold today to see plenty of Buyers starting with an 17m Limousin from JR Smith making £2800 to feed. Simmental Bulls from Messrs Sutton down from Cheshire saw 5m to £1330 and £1250 before a run of Hereford Bulls saw Messrs Jones Ag Contractors top at £1710 for Herefords 13m with others £1620 and £1590. A super run of Charolais Bulls down from G R Hallifield Farms this week saw 8 -11m Bulls top out at £2230, £2120, £2110 to see the wagon load avg £1720.

Into the young Cattle and serious trade for the better end with Herefords from C & S Taylor, Armscote selling yearlings at £1460 and £1400 for Steers. The annual consignment of Salers from DT & DJ Mann saw a super run of yearlings top at £1780 for 6 strong Steers with Heifers to £1500. Quality street next with yearling Limousin from R A Stephens seeing a pair top at at £2110 and others £2080, £2010 with Heifers £1500. Next AMrk and Tom Lambert selling Buckets at 13m to £1710 for Angus Steers with Blues £1690 and Heifers £1510. Trade steadying all last week and deadweight falls aplenty. Truth of the matter being Sales just remain very slow in Europe and even slower in Europe. Export Hoggs holding up to return an SQQ of 345.6p/kg heavies though getting harder and harder with a real national over supply and deadweight firms penalising hard. Export weights though a nice trade seeing Dickler Farms, Stow on the Wold dominate with shape and meat selling Beltex to 433p/kg and 429p/kg for 40 & 42kg. K Crabtree with shape and finish saw 44kg at 425p/kg. Plenty of meat Hoggs beating the 400p/kg mark with anything carrying shape past this point. Meat Export Hoggs 370p/kg plus but lean Export hoggs and Hoggs over 44kg trading 300- 345p/ kg. Weight remains very hard to sell seeing K Crabtree buck the trend with his meat to sell 49kg at 398p/ kg and Amorise Ltd 46kg at 393p/kg. Andy Mitchell showing the best finished Hoggs of the day at 49kg to 371p/kg. Weighted Hoggs regularly 320 – 330 if shape but run of the Mill weight now trading 290 – 300p/kg and super heavies and the plain less money. Weight really very hard to sell throughout. All in Avg of £153.30 still respectable albeit the Store Hogg trade having took the shine off things. In the lump Export Hoggs to £189 for 45kg from K Crabtree whom also took £187 for 44kg and £182. A Green £180.50 at 44kg and Dickler Farms 42kg at £180.

Top gross for the day D P Mitchell & Son, Rugby with 54kg at £200 with K Crabtree £195 and £190 equal with FJ Tombs & Son.

Weighted Continental actively £230-£250 with leaner sorts or those lacking weight £170-£180.


