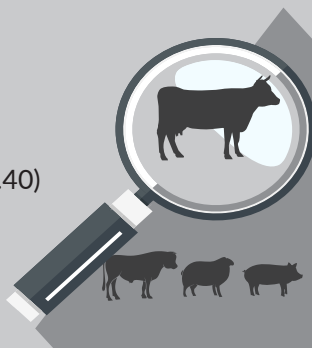

## STORE CATTLE 12.06.25



An unseasonably large entry of Store Cattle for June met a large ringside of Buyers dominated by new faces travelling from Yorkshire to Wales and back again. After an absolutely storming trade for Weanlings the Store Cattle could have been the Bridesmaids but none of it. The regular Cattle deadweight drops of the last few weeks being forgotten and Buyers remaining acutely aware of the National shortage of feeding Cattle.

Starting with the Feeding Bulls Camilla and Roger Coombes taking £900 for Angus outlier Buckets 14m of age. Another draw from the Astley branch of the Townshed Partners seeing a continued wave of trade with Blonde Bulls 9m to £1500.

Cows and Calves next with Avon Blue selling to a top of £2120 for a 2017 Angus Cow and her 2m Simmental Bull Calf with others £1880 and £1830. Grazing Cows next saw a top of £1890 for Avon Blue.

Into the Store Cattle and Townshend Partners selling Angus Steers 11m at £1360 and Blonde Heifers to £1280 and £1240. Next in P Dyson with yearling Limousin x Heifers at £1400 and £1370. J Hubbard & Son for a nother week with Angus bucket Steers 17m at £2020 and sisters £1800. A T Harrison then similar Buckets at £1700 for Hereford Heifers. Super reared Blues from J Jackson next selling Steers to £2360 and £2300 21m of age, Then into 120 aged Stores from Avon Blue. Meeting great interest they kicked off this run of Buckets Cattle ran across two summers with a Limousin Steer 16m at £1710. 22m Heifers saw Simmentals at £1600 and £1510. Into the main bulk of the Cattle with most 26 - 27m of age. Angus kicked us off at £1800 and £1720 with sisters £1420. Into the Blues a top of £1700 and £1680 with sisters £1780 and £1600. A selection of aged Cattle to meet all jobs and all price ranges.

Next P S Hemming and A Goolding with Messrs Hemming 24m Limousin x Heifers at £1760 Holstein none breeders to £1420. K Attfield down from Leicester to end the day with Angus Steers £1980 22m and equal age Lincoln Reds £1820.

### *Prime Cattle-*

*A very mixed show today in terms of quality and this reflected in the averages. Some fantastically finished cattle forward however very few of those best end, suckler bred sorts in the entry. Trade remaining similar and holding well against the continually sliding deadweight.*

### *Bullocks-*

*Very few of those best sorts forward but anything suckler bred with cover still a real trade. Top of the pops saw GR Fountaine & Son selling Limousins to 405p/kg, with PC & RA Nichols seeing Simmentals to a top of 395p/kg, just pipping David Ofield who sold weight to 390p/kg, 382p/kg and 367p/kg.*

*Weight still totting up nicely with GR Fountaine to £2786.40 with David Ofield topping his run at £2753.40, £2750.40 and £2723.14.*

### *Heifers-*

*The Fountaines flying high here too with super Limousin heifers to 417p/kg, with the same home cruising to 406p/kg. 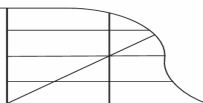

SQQ 360P/KG AVG £151.40 TOP £202

A good yarding all around with over 2500 Prime Sold on the Three Counties week. Traditionally this being the week that trade falls away. In truth a continued buoyancy in Sales and Export weight and Heavy Lambs meeting a good demand. Middle weight Lambs 43.5 to 46kg harder placed. Despite this an SQQ of 360p/kg a real return for a June yarding that had a large proportion of grass fed Mule bred lambs. A fair two tier trade between fed and grass fed lambs with Export weight Fed lambs all trading 380 plus and quality shape all into the 400p/kg plus range with grass fed lambs trading 330 plus. Today some real nice top end lambs full of meat but a yarding lacking quality compared to the previous week. Top today small but perfect Beltex from Angela Russell at 35kg and 454p/kg with a upper run from BJ & IS Wain seeing 38kg Beltex at 442p/kg 37kg at 438p/kg 39kg at 431p/kg and 41kg at 429p/kg. A super run from the Wain family of genuine Spring lambs. J & R Lowe with all the meat to sell 41kg at 429p/kg and GR Fountaine & Son 40kg at 425p/kg. Messrs Freer & Son, AR & J Collett, Greatworth Hall, KW Ormond & Son, J Grace, M Bills, Hyde Lane Farms and Long Partners all breaking 400p/kg. Weighted Lambs past 43.5kg again harder to sell with home trade limited for Carcass meat and Exporters demanding handy weights today perhaps a 15p discount over spec weights. In the heavies a real step forwards as the Hoggs dry and Australian Hoggs drastically increasing in cost. Weight today to 392p/kg at 49kg for M Bills, Market Bosworth with Hyde Lane Farms 46.5kg at 391p/kg and equal money for 46kg. W J Pearson 52kg 385p/kg with Messrs Lowe and Toon 48 & 46kg at 383p/kg.

An all in Avg of £152 a nice return for the time of year. Export Lambs topping at £179 for 44kg for J & R Lowe whom also sold 41kg at £176. MM Clarke & Sons 45kg at £174 with W J Pearson 42kg to £172. Heavy weights though back in vogue and selling to a massive £202 for 57kg from J Webster with W J Pearson & Son £200 at 52kg J Webster £199 with RAE Wilson £197 at 57kg with E Brain & Son £196 at 57kg.

Trade likely to now slip as numbers hit the market and it is imperative that Lambs are now fully meat prior to drawing.
