Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

Jane Gilbert sweeping in with the quality to see loads of interest for better bred sorts selling to a top of £2930 for Limousin Steers 21m she sold Limousin Steers at 18m and 15m at £2300. Heifers to £2300 18m. A returning Customer next when the MJ & JR Taylor sold the best run of aged Blue Buckets you are likely to see. Topping the run at £2500 for 20m others sold at £2320, £2280, £2260, £2260 and £2140 all 19 – 21m. Charolais from the same £2320. Last man in, a new Customer with TB4 Cattle over from Ely saw Mr C Attle take a marvellous run of Blondes. Steers 21m at £2180 and £1980 with Sisters £2120. Continental heifers to £500 for Simmentals from GTA Hall, with Limousins from Mike Pearson to £495. Blues from RJ Cole sold to £450 and £445 with RC & J Mann selling Angus to £355. Fortnight old Hereford heifer calves sold to £305 for Border Holdings, with Black and White Bulls from the same home to £130.

A tidy show of prime cattle today and trade holding firm against the continuingly dropping deadweight sector. Meat remaining the key to maximising returns and numbers continue to be wanted by a plethora of both butcher and wholesale buyers at ringside.

Bullocks-

A real corker from Cecil and Family topping at 440p/kg for a super Limousin sired steer, with the same home seeing big lads to 433p/kg. Robert and Tom Reeve saw Limousins to 422p/kg, with homebred steers from JD Stephens selling to 405p/kg, ahead of J & P Seymour selling to 399p/kg.

In the lump today big fella's from CW Thomas topped at £3368.74, with the Reeve stable to £3072.16. Ivor Caswell saw heavyweight to £2847.00 with the Newbury stable selling to £2738.24. Plenty of cattle today with weight trading upwards of £2500 today.

Spring Lambs;

More about and some super genuine Spring Lambs albeit more weight than is needed with real premiums for lightweight Lambs. No real Beltex sorts but some well finished Lambs in the SQQ of 380p/kg together with a fair few grass finished and the odd rare breed and Cade Lambs. Buyers much more numerous for Spring Lambs than Hoggs. Shaped well finished Texels from C & A Morely saw 40kg 430p/kg with FI & EJ Barnes 40kg 426p/kg equal with Dennis & John Clarke. Messrs Morely then 425 & 421p/kg equal with P Cobley. Well finished Export Weight Lambs 385 – 408p/kg. Grass fed springers 360p/kg mark an lambs fed but 43kg plus 365p – 375p/kg. Weighted heavy Lambs trading at perhaps only a 10p/kg premium of Hoggs. Nice bloomed Lambs well chased. Top today £172 for 40kg from C & A Morley with £171 for 48kg from MM Clarke & Sons with Messrs Barnes and A Morris still breaking the £170 mark.

Trade very selective with Hoggs meeting large resistance on the Sales counters throughout. Meat in short supply today and unsheared Hoggs staring to sweat there backs off. Export Hoggs with meat well chased with another Account looking for Spec Hoggs. Heavy Hoggs remain a hard Sale and large amount of plain Heavy Hoggs steadying trade today. An SQQ of 322.24p/kg about the highest in the Land and for that a small mercy of appreciation. Top today 423p/kg at 35kg for shaped shorn Hoggs from J Redfern down from Staffordshire. J Hope & Son 40kg 410p/kg for lovely meated Hoggs well appreciated. F A Walker Beltex x Cheviots 394p/kg. Export Weights with meat 360p/kg plus. Export weights shorter on meat 330p/kg plus with 44kg discounted 10p/kg in each case. Heavies trading 250 - 300p/kg for run of the Mill. Top weighted Hoggs 48p/kg to 375p/kg for P F Edwards and 362p/kg at 47kg from Jack Plant down from Buxton and Lilbourne Turf 48kg at 354p/kg. IN the Lump a top today of £180 for P Edwards at 48kg with J Plant £170 equal with Lilbourne Turf whilst Humphrey Livestock £169.


