Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

Meat aplenty amongst the pens and gobbled up by the hungry buying power at ringside. Yet more fresh buying accounts at ringside with numbers no problem and more wanted each and every week to maintain current buying support.

Steers

Some real class and power in the steers this week, with some super runs of fed cattle gracing the ring.

Top p/kg this week to a superb Blonde bullock from N & T Faulconbridge selling to 438p/kg, with John and Cathy Stephens selling homebred Limousins to 434p/kg. Handyweights from LW Howe sold 431p/kg with the same home selling to 411p/kg. Top grossing bullock saw big Blonde lads to £3267.48 from the Faulconbridge stable, with WR Keeves selling big Charolais steers to £3150 ahead of Edward Hull also breaking the £3k barrier at £3115.40. Plenty of heavyweight meated bullocks today trading upward of £2700 with lots of ringside enquiry.

Heifers

Just wow! Some corking heifers throughout today with Butchers and Wholesalers battling toe to toe for properly meated heifers.

Top p/kg today from A Bishop up from Pitfield selling 485p/kg with the same home soaring away to 480p/kg. Parry Walters sold to a top of 452p/kg, with our very own Cecil Thomas selling to 450p/kg, with John Stephens selling to 442p/kg for homebred Limousins.

Flying high in the lump today saw CW Thomas selling to £3042.00 for British Blues with DTP Walters to a top of £3028.40 for Limousins. W & M Emery sold to £2825.80 for Charolais with dairy bred Angus selling to £2804.88 from DJ Hull.

Bulls

SQQ 350.65P/KG AVG £150.06 TOP £190 for G & E Livestock

More about but not really a yard of quality. In line with the national trend a steady in trade with orders slow after Ramadan and prior to Easter build up with trade likely to lift anyday. An SQQ of 350p/kg though putting us in the top few for the day despite a showing of Hoggs still short of finish. Those with meat well rewarded with a full ringside of Buyers in attendance. Top for the day Beltex from J & H Tustian 469p/kg and 438p/kg for 40kg and Alex Edwards down from Derbyshire 417p/kg and Passmore & Nunnerley 415p/kg 41kg equal with J A Boulton. Plenty of Hoggs trading over 400p/kg if meated albeit this section short on supply this week. Export Hoggs with meat generally breaking 360p/kg with leaner Export types 340 – 350p/kg. This weeks major difference the half meat Hoggs trading 320 – 340p/kg and certainly the most affected. Lean Hoggs still remain bet sold as Store Lambs on a Thursday. Weight today easier sold in places for all but the large low grading sorts. Shapier shorn Hoggs to 396p/kg for 48kg from G & E Livestock and 46kg from J & H Tustian. Messrs G & E Livestock 372p/kg for 46kg. Heavies with shape regularly 320p/kg but run of the mill, dirty or fat Hoggs trading around 300p/kg.

An all in average of £150 again puts everything into perspective with returns still very good for an average that includes various runs of Shetland bred Sheep.

In the lump Export Hoggs to £185 for 45kg from Humphrey Livestock and £180 for J & H Tustian whom also sold 40kg for £175. Plenty of Export Hoggs still passing £160. Overall a top of £190 for 48kg from G & E Livestock with shape and weight and Hillside Farm £185. Messrs Fenemore, Tustian and Humphrey Livestock and G & E Livestock also breaking £180.

Trade harder around the country and seemingly the Hoggs not fleshing as we would like. That said a fair trade and hopefully Easter puts an added demand in coming weeks.
Hoggs today presented dirty and these discounted heavily with some Abbatoirs unwilling to bid. TEETH UP is now an issue as per common law this is the sellers responsibility to declare.
Selling these in the Fat Hoggs falls under mis-descriptions Act as Teeth up Hoggs must be split.
With the current good fortunes of the Ewe Section Teeth up are best marketed in the Ewes.


