VET ATTESTATIONS



Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abbattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e. being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

Prime Cattle-

As good a yard of cattle today as we have seen, with some super sorts forward today. Trade holding firm against reports of sliding deadweight prices and numbers continue to be wanted with another wholesale account at ringside today.

Bullocks-

Flying high today saw NAS Johnson selling proper Limousin bullock with length and width to a top of 460p/kg, with the same stable selling to a top of 455p/kg. Pete Jarrom with a corking Blue sired bullock topped at 451p/kg, while Parthenais with weight from H & J East sold to a top of 440p/kg. Dairy bred Blues from DD Pugh saw 408p/kg. Top grossing bullock to a top of £3472.70 for a Blue bullock nearly as wide as long, with John East hot on his heels selling to £3239.52. Nice to see Poplar Farming down from Derbyshire with a Simmental bullock as fit as fire to £2979.60.

Heifers-

Some proper goods on offer today with NAS Johnson topping here too with a 43 month Limousin heifer to a whopping 461p/kg. GR Fountaine with beautifully fleshed goods to 446p/kg. Messrs Friswell topped at 441p/kg, with R Ellis & Son to 430p/kg. Stretchy 43 month Limousin heifers to £2978.06 from NAS Johnson, with Poplar Farming to £2810.88 for thick British Blue heifers, just pipping R Ellis & Son selling to £2752.00.

Bulls-

Only a handful of bulls today and more desperately wanted by the buying support at ringside.

Top today saw G Potter with Blue bulls to a top of 390p/kg, or £2308.28.

Cows-

Cow trade bobbing along and meat remaining a premium.

Top of the tree today saw Richard Ellis with proper Limousin slips to 306p/kg, with R & T Reeve to 296p/kg, and JK Smith & Sons to 290p/kg.

Top gross saw R Ellis to £2619.36, with R & T Reeve to £2214.08.

Stock bulls saw an absolute corker of a Blue bull trading to 302p/kg or £3358.24 for J & H Tustian.

A mixed show of 1700 Hoggs

A two tier trade appearing, anything meat in spec very very well chased. Heavy Hoggs dearer than alternative options but harder to place and lean Hoggs now facing realisation rates. 400p/kg still obtainable for handyweight quality with 38kg at 400p/kg and 35kg for Henry Tustian the same. Meated handy weights 350p/kg plus. Leaner Export Hoggs trading around 300p/kg. Weighted Hoggs 260 to 300p/kg. In the Lump Hoggs to £181 for J Hope & Son with £180 for C W Glover & Son and £172 for R J Bevin and F O Adams & Son. Messrs RJ Mawby and Hull Farms both breaking £170.

Spring Lambs;

Numbers slowly building but for some reason a wealth of weight throughout and more Lambs 43kg plus than below. Ideally 36 to 41kg needed and weight Lambs currently competing against a struggling Hogg trade. An SQQ of 347p/kg perhaps a little reduced by the number of weighted Lambs on parade with handy weights regularly trading 370p/kg plus. Top today 421p/kg for the only real Texel sorts on parade from E Brains & Sons Ltd at 39kg and with GR Fountaine & Son 38kg at 421p/kg. Messrs Fountaine 406 and 411p/kg. Messrs MM Clarke & Sons, D & GM Wright, FI & EJ Barnes and R F Leach surpassing 400p/kg. Handy weights slightly more stale trading 360 – 380p/kg and Lambs over 42kg disadvantaged by 15p/kg upto 44kg. Heavies a harder sell throughout as the compete with Hoggs. In the lump a top of £180 for B Burrow & Sons with 56kg whilst J Webster saw £165.50 and Micky Fox £166.

Best end Continental ewes lacking the weight today, but those heavier end trading up to £243 for E Hicks, with RJ Mawby to £240 with J & H Tustian to £228. Heavy Continental ewes trading £180-£200 with medium types £140-£160. Leaner goods trading £120-£130 and would look well sold.

Suffolks saw whoppers from D Taylor topping at £236, with S & J Farming selling to £232. Weight £190+ with lighter weight meat selling £160-£170. Leaner sorts wanted

still and trading £120-£130.

Mules looking the trade of the day with heavyweight fleshed Mules trading to £181 from W & I Grindal, GR Fountaine selling to the same figure.
