VET ATTESTATIONS



WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abbattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e. being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

Prime Cattle-

A mixed yarding today, with shape and meat commanding a real premium, but some of those more commercial goods harder to place as deadweight grids tighten and prices tumble. The rings still holding trade firm however there is now starting to be plenty of resistance from the end users as cheaper meat seeps onto the market.

Bullocks-

A proper Blue sire bullock roaring to the top of todays trade sold to 420p/kg from J Cooper & Son, with Frank Osborne back in the fold selling to 381p/kg, just pipping D Powers selling 35 month steers to 380p/kg. Salers from BT Caswell topped at 371p/kg with J & P Seymour selling to 370p/kg. David Ofield saw properly meated sorts to 363p/kg with heavyweights to 361p/kg.

Heavyweight Angus steers topped the gross figures at £2898.20 for DJ Hull, with DA Ofield selling Charolais to £2830.24. Dave Powers topped his day to £2801.40 with Frank Osborne selling to £2758.04.

Heifers-

Flying high in the heifers too saw J Cooper & Son selling to 429p/kg with a brace of heifers from LW Howe selling to 411p/kg & 410p/kg with Ian Wain to 407p/kg for a properly fed Limousin heifer.

Top grossing heifer to J Cooper & Son, with Pure Blue sorts to £2634.06, ahead of J & R Lowe, with Limousins to £2617.44 and DA Ofield to £2613.04.

Bulls-

A shorter show and the bull section the hardest hit by the trade slide.
Top today say Ted Taylor with Limousin bulls to 350p/kg, with the same home to
338p/kg, topping at £2541.76.

Cows-

A tidy show of meat cows saw a top of 282p/kg for Limousin cows from H Smith & Son, with R & T Reeve selling to 279p/kg for Angus with Simmentals from the same home to 275p/kg.

Top grossing cows saw heavyweight Hereford cows full of meat from DJ Hull & Partners to £2400.90, with the same stable to £2217.20.

Less about as is usual for the first day after the closing of the Festival. Those that braved the trade well rewarded with best and well fed Lambs a fast trade. Under finished Lambs starting to creep into the yards today and heavily discounted. An SQQ of 358p/kg a massive return when considering the huge Deadweight falls of last week. Best end Lambs regularly trading 395p/kg plus with a top of 421 & 420p/kg from MG & SM Grindal at 41kg with P Cobley, Leicester Beltex 418p/kg 38kg and C & A Morley down from Clipston with proper meated Texels at 410p/kg,40kg. Meat the order of the day with less Customers at ringside following the end of the Festival and a few Abbatoirs deciding not to open. Meated fed Lambs 360p/kg plus with Grass fed sorts trading 340p/kg mark. Weights 43 to 46kg a stickier trade with demand less for these weight, Heavy Lambs a shaper trade and 47kg from S Parry trading at 350p/kg with others with weight mid 340's. In the lump Export weight Lambs to £174 for P Cobley at 43kg and £172 for MG & SM Grindal at 41kg with others at £168. Top today £178 for 55kg from MM Clarke & Sons with S Parry 53kg at £176. Today 204 Lambs trading over £160.
