Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abbattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

CATTLE : 67 Forward



Prime Cattle -

A shorter harvest type entry as vendors turn their attention to silage and grass work. Meat still key to maximising returns and vendors should ensure that cattle are drawn "fit".

Bullocks-

A run of storming Limousin bullocks from Passmore Brothers, Wallingford dominated the steer entry with weight, shape and finish soaring to a top of 414p/kg with weight, and others from the same home selling to 409p/kg, 408p/kg and 404p/kg. N & T Faulconbridge matched the figure with Blondes to 404p/kg, with GR Fountaine & Son to 400p/kg. Top gross saw the Passmore Brothers smashing the top spots with weighted Limousin steers to £3076.32, with the same home to £3051.14 and £3013.92. Dairy Bred Angus from DJ Hull & Partners soared to £3001.04, with AGM Farndon with heavyweight Charolais to £2834.80.

Heifers -

Not content with dominating the bullock section, the Passmore Brothers saw corking Limousin heifers to a top of 409p/kg, with the same home to 407p/kg. Cecil Thomas saw heavyweight Limousin heifers to 400p/kg, with DJ Hull & Partners to 390p/kg, matching Limousins from GR Fountaine, with Angus close behind from J Windridge & Son to 380p/ kg.

Heifers grossing a whopping £2928.44 for Limousins from the Passmore Brothers, with DJ Hull to £2923.14 for OTM Angus heifers. CW Thomas sold to £2800 for Limousins with DJ Hull selling Blues to £2637.42.

Bulls -

Desperately short in the bull section with customers at ringside wanting bulls. Top of the tree today saw P & N Allen, Uttoxeter, with handyweight Blue Bulls to a top of 324p/kg or £1419.12.

Cows

More more more needed, with cow customers requiring numbers of meated cows to ensure supply. Whether beef or dairy sired, big, small or indifferent, there is demand for them all! Top today saw DJ Hull & Partners selling to 284p/kg, with the same home to 283p/kg for young Limousin cows.

Top grossing cows sold to $\pounds2233.04$ for J Windridge & Son with the same home to $\pounds2227.32.$




