VET ATTESTATIONS



Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abbattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e. being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

CATTLE: 86 Forward



Prime Cattle -

A tidy summer show of cattle, with a properly meated yard forward. Demand could be described as a shade firmer with those properly fed sorts ringing the bell.

Bullocks-

A real show of bullocks saw a whopper from NAS Johnson with Limousins to 423p/kg with weight, with the same home to 422p/kg. BJ & IS Wain saw handy little box fed Limousin steers to 415p/kg just ahead of Sansome & Morgan with Limousins to 412p/kg GR Fountaine & Son sold to 408p/kg with handy Limousins from PM Jarrom to 394p/kg. Top grossing bullocks from NAS Johnson saw Limousins to £2969.46, with Sansome & Morgan selling to £2869.36. DA Ofield saw heavyweight Blues to £2771.48, with AGM Farndon selling to £2723.04.

Heifers-

A real corking heifer from everyone's favourite haulier saw Jamie Collins selling extreme Limousin heifers to 448p/kg, with BJ & IS Wain selling to 432p/kg for homebred, fed Limousin heifers. Jamie sold others to 412p/kg and 410p/kg, with David Ofield soaring to 402p/kg, with dairy bred sorts from A Sabin to 389p/kg.

Heifers today topping at £2600 for Ian Wain, with Jamie Collins seeing £2544.64 for a proper Limousin. Angus from RW & HER Trivett sold £2509.92 with Blues from DJ Hull to £2380.12.

Bulls-

A handy little show of bulls with more wanted each week to meet buyer demand.

Top today saw handyweight Blondes from Jasper Hart selling to 371p/kg, with G Potter selling to 369p/kg for British Blues. Black and whites a real trade today saw a top of 330p/kg from RR Barrett & Son.

Top grossing bulls sold to a top of £2422.92 from PM Wilks, with G Potter to £2140.20 for Blues. Black & Whites sold to £1914 from RR Barrett & Son.

Cows -

Cows very much a stand of trade, with meated cows from PM Wilks selling to a top of 278p/kg with Hollinshead Farms to 277p/kg.

Top grossing cows sold £2124.54 for Angus from WS Harrison & Sons, with Hollinshead Farms to £2066.42.

LAMBS 2405 FORWARD

SQQ 344P/KG AVG £144

Lambs:

As regular as Tax and inevitable as death the Seasonal fall of the Spring Lamb trade. We dodged Three Counties week but Royal Show week saw the demand for Lambs drop below Supply with trade back significantly and deadweights stopping taking bookings. With delivered prices to central Europe now on £7.50kg not much room for manoeuvre for processors even after the drop. Buyers short at ringside with orders short at the Sales counter with the Hot weather further slowing demand. Today a yarding of 2400 Lambs with a fair few rushing to get numbers off the land with the current drought. Trade though still favourable here with an SQQ of 344p/kg well ahead especially considering a fair wealth of lean grass lambs today many short of back. Best end lambs still breaking 400p/kg with 410p/kg for 40kg from W Bartlett and 402p/kg at 41kg for DJ & ST Webb. 42kg at 400p/ kg for W Bartlett. Meat Export weight with shape regularly 380p/kg plus. Meat in general trading 350 – 360p/kg. With first cross fed Lambs 340-350p/kg and grass fed 320-330p/ kg. Verv Lean Lambs more akin to Stores trading 310 – 320. Lightweight Lambs hardest sold and lots on the Market alongside grass fed lightweights. Export trade limiting demand. Weight a better Sale throughout as the home trade runs short of cheap imported Lamb Cuts. Weight seeing twice as much audience throughout albeit the weight seeing much better finished lambs as a rule. Top today ¾ Texels from Robert and Rosie Leach with 51kg at 394p/ kg whilst similar goods from RR & M Lawrence down from Market Bosworth 47kg at 386p/ kg and Gloucestershire's GM Bennett & Partners 51kg at 384p/kg. Messrs Lawrence & Leadbeater both also taking 383p/kg. Weight generally surpassing 360p/kg and Lambs over 45.5kg today trading at an Avg of 367p/kg.

An all in avg of £144 still well ahead of this time last year especially considering two large runs of Lambs from Tegs weighing 33 – 37kg. Export weights totting to £170 at 44kg for GR Fountaine & Son with W Bartlett £168 for 42kg and R Leach £168 at 44kg. Plenty of best fed Lambs trading £150 to £160. Heavies the real demand of the day selling to a top of £205.50 for Hyde Lane Farms at 60kg. R Deacon continues to bring impressive meat weekly to sell to £205 at 58kg with Ted Taylor 57kg at £201.50 and RF Leach 51kg at £201. Meat and finish really paying.

We Thank everyone for there help and patience Yesterday. The Staff started sorting at 5.30am and worked all day in Temperatures over 32 degrees. Thanks to all Hauliers and Farmers for assisting as and when.

Weather conditions are trying and this is noted by all but Vendors are encouraged to feed lambs for best returns with lean Lambs now flooding the Trade and causing difficult Sales for Processors. Feed is indeed at reasonable rates and with Lambs still trading ahead of last year feeding makes sense.
