STORE CATTLE 10.07.25



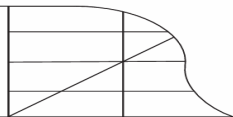
An above average number of Store Cattle for July. Weather conditions and lack of grass expected to temper demand, but none of it, seemingly optimism for the future Beef trade greater than the fear of lack of fodder. Kicking us off M Peebles with his expertly reared Bucket sorts selling at £910 8m of age for Limousin x Steers with Angus at £805 and Blue Heifers at 9m to £860. Next in local man F & J Clarke sold a good trance of 24 Cattle making best use of his Local Sale Centre to return an Avg over £1050 for 12 -14, Shorthorns. Topping at £1400 for Beef Shorthorn Steers 13m with others £1330, £1240 & £1200. Sisters saw £1140, £1030, £1085 and £1010 with even the harder sone in the £900's. Cummins & Bickford sold Bucket sorts today seeing 11m Blue Steers to £1250 & £1240 with Limousin £1195 and Holsteins to £795. Blue Sisters £960. J Waterfield down out of Leicestershire saw Steers to £1220 for Simmentals 16m before Markets Bosworths' J Jackson sold wonderfully presented Simmental Steers to £1990 22m and even better Heifers £1910.

Hollinshead Farms with some real breeding seeing a trade that requires a upward shift in the Fat Cattle returns to provide equity when taking a pair of Limousin Steers 23 & 22m at £2055 with others 15 to 17m £1790, £1700 & £1690. Sisters to £1770 at 24 months.

Prime Cattle-

A shorter, harvest show of cattle but very much a stand on trade with meat remaining key to maximising returns. Returning accounts at ringside showing an increased appetite for meat.

Bullocks-

Some storming bullocks on offer with properly fed, thick meat goods a real trade. Top of the pops today saw distance traveller KS Mayfield & Co, Melton Mowbray selling to a top of 419p/kg for stylish Limousin bullocks, with the same home to 405p/kg. Big lads from Cecil Thomas saw shape to 400p/kg, with Edward Hull seeing handy weight Limousin bullocks to the same figure. The dairy boys performing well with dairy bred Limousins to 390p/kg from FE & CJ Barnett.

Top gross today for 32month Limousin steers from Dave Powers with weight trading to £179.52, with Cecil Thomas selling to £3152.00. The Mayfield stable topped at £2874.34, with Ed Hull to £2779.00.

Heifers-

Firing on all cylinders, the heifer trade saw butchers and wholesalers toe to toe competing anything properly fed.

Topping the section saw Morgan and Sansome with a thick meat Limousin heifer to 431p/kg, with CW Thomas selling Blues to 418p/kg, with homebred heifers from Richard Lowe to 417p/kg just pipping Parry Walters to 415p/kg.

Weight from Cecil Thomas saw Blues to £2892.56, with Parry Walter selling Limousins to £2776, just ahead of Morgan and Sansome who sold to £2747.

Bulls-

A handy entry of bulls but more remain wanted by the competitive buying support at ringside.

Top today saw Pedigree Limousins from Richard Lowe selling to 382p/kg or £3170.60.

Dairy Bred Blue from Pete Allen saw handy weights to 368p/kg with Limousin x from Pete Hemmings to 343p/kg.

LAMBS 2314 FORWARD

SQQ 360.30P/KG AVG £154 TOP £216

A bumper yarding of over 2300 at a time when numbers are less further north and south led to a real trade for fed meat with an SQQ 360p/kg. Fed meat and weight the order of the day but Customers keen for meat throughout. Weight though a real benefit this year and lighter weight lambs being shipped of farms short of grass leading to an oversupply Nationally and consequentially a decrease in value for this commodity. Meat Lambs 42kg plus and heavies though a real flyer as are best shaped. Top today Blue Texel Shape from AF HJ Neal at 414p/kg with DS & LE Wadland 412 & 413p/kg at 41kg. whilst SF Taylor, GR Fountaine & Son, Messrs Neal and J Bury all 410p/kg. Shaped lambs today all breaking 400p/kg providing a level of cover. Meat first cross lambs generally 368p/kg plus with better bred 10p dearer. Leaner Grass lambs 340 to 355p/kg. Weight a real demand and the overall avg equal to the SQQ on the day showing little discount. Top weighted lamb saw 391p/kg at 46kg from Chiltern Beltex with MM Clarke & Sons topping there run at 383p/kg for pens at 47kg with MG & SM Grindal 46kg at 378p/kg. K Attfield, DS & LE Wadland and J Baker & Sons 374p/kg all at 50kg. Weight generally all over 350p/kg with only the very lean less.

An all in Avg across the 2318 Lambs seen and Sold of £154 which in July is phenomenal and well ahead of last year or indeed past history. Export Lambs to £176 for 45kg from J Dronfield with weight and shape and Alwyn Williams £172 at 44kg with SF Taylor £171. A Williams also £170 at 42kg. Overall and £200 passed on 16 pens today! Top of the pops though MM Clarke & Sons 64kg at £216 with Fordwall Farm Partners £214 at 59kg and A Williams 60kg at £212. Messrs Tombs x4, EJ Taylor & Son, K Attfield, A Williams and MM Clarke & Sons x4 and WJ Barnett & Sons all breaking the £200 mark. Today 180 lambs making over £180.

With the weather conditions being hard but the trading conditions favourable it is essential Vendors invest in hard feed at a time when Cereal Commodities are reasonably priced.

Best Continentals flying to a top of £292 for purebred Texels from Fordwell Partners, with the same home selling to a top of £242. Chiltern Beltex up from Bicester selling to £233 with the same stable to £232.

Weighted Continentals on the whole trading £195-£205, with lighter weight, meated ewes £160-£170. Leaner sorts £120-£130 and well sold.

Suffolks not seeing the quality on offer as last week, but topping at £193 from Ted Taylor, with RW Kerby selling to £192. Weighted Suffolks generally £170-£180 with lighter goods £140-£150.

Mules soaring to £194 for a monster from Ted Taylor, with G Scrivens selling to £188 for pens full. Meat generally £140-£150, with lighter goods £120-£130 and grazers around the £100 mark.
