

Prime Cattle -

More vendors returning to the fold and trade firmer again on the week as the live ring flexes its muscles and shows what it can do.

Bullocks-

Some super sorts forward today saw a real corker from Nigel and Simon Johnson flying to 447p/kg, with the same home dominating the bullocks to 434p/kg, 424p/kg and 422p/kg. AA Fyfe saw sharp Blue sire bullocks to 420p/kg, with GR Fountaine to 418p/kg. Returning face Terry Kenealy topped his run of bullocks at 409p/kg.

The Johnson boys topping the gross figures with big lads to £3004.64, with the same stable to £2864.40 and £2840.80. The Kenealy stable sold to a top of £2764.84. PC & RA Nichols & Son sold grazed Charolais to £2747.70.

Heifers -

A whopping Blue heifer saw TV & J Kenealy selling to 431p/kg, with GR Fountaine to 422p/kg. Dairy bred Blues from DJ Hull & Partners to 394p/kg with the same stable to 390p/kg, just pipping Chris Clayton at 388p/kg.

Big girls proving beautiful with Charolais heifers to £2675.20 from PC & RA Nichols, with the Kenealy stable seeing Simmentals to £2607.00 and Angus to £2554.20.

Bulls -

A mixed show and more wanted by ringside buying support.

Top of the pops today saw Alan Tacy selling to 377p/kg for Limousin x bulls with CH Evans & Son selling to 357p/kg for Simmentals. Native bulls to 347p/kg for HC & CW Farming.

Top gross saw Simmentals for CH Evans selling to £2534.70.

Cows-

A stand on trade with some nicely fed cows on offer.

Lambs;

The gift that keeps giving. Miles ahead of local comparison deadweight or liveweight, Nationally up on the year and all this in July, traditionally a difficult time to Market Lambs. Weather conditions have dictated that we are having to feed Lambs but the return on investment is very appealing. An SQQ today of 361p/kg representing a serious return with numbers tighter across the Nation today. Meat lambs very well rewarded throughout. Lighter lambs a little harder to shift and weight still in favour. Perhaps a small slow in very heavy lamb trade but only a few pounds for those over 53kg. Top today saw a massive top of 427p/kg from J Rutter & Son for Beltex with Small but shape from A F Neal 423p/kg. Plenty over 400p/kg and real meat from C & A Morley 42kg at 405p/kg and W Bartlett, Brackley and HW & AJ Eadon both 400p/kg at 42kg. Meat and shape very well chased. Leaner lambs hardest sold throughout. Meat first cross generally 350 - 380p/kg with leaner sorts trading 330 - 350p/kg and Stores 300p/kg. Weight still a nice trade throughout with 46kg from C & A Morley topping at 385p/kg with FJ Tombs & Son 49.5kg 384p/kg for the usual exceptional meat. D Edwards up from the south to see 50kg at 380p/kg equal with MM Clarke & Sons. Weight under 53kg generally 350p/kg plus subject to finish.

In the lump an all in avg of £155 per head for July simply brilliant. Export Lambs topping at £174 for 44kg from W Bartlett with G L Woodard 44kg at £172 an C & A Morley 43.5kg at £172. Plenty of Export weights today blasting past £160. Overall a top of £204 for MM Clarke & Sons at 60kg with K Attfield down from Leicester with a super run of meat to see £200 at 61kg and £195, £194 and £193 for 52 - 56kg.

Keep feeding them is the message. Trade beneficial and returns favourable.

Just over 700 forward and trade very similar, albeit the averages very much telling the quality on offer. A large yarding of grazers seeing two fresh buying accounts opening up alongside the usual weekly supporters.

Best end white faced ewes remaining a strong trade, with GR Fountaine topping the day with Texels to £238. VR Phipps hot on their heels selling Texels to £235. Heavyweight Charolais from FJ Tombs selling to £218, ahead of Texels from Messrs Taylor & Son to £205.

Heavyweight ewes actively trading £190-£200 with medium continentals £165-£175. Smaller ewes £130-£140.

Suffolks to a top of £195 for big pens from H Faulkener & Sons, with MR Grindal & Son selling to £195. Weighted Suffolks all £180 plus with mediums on the whole £150-£160. Smaller meated ewes £120-£130 with the very lean under £100.

Mules to £188 for a pair of whoppers from Taylor & Son, with pens of 17 to £179 from J Baker & Sons. Heavyweight Mules generally £160-£170, with smaller sorts £130-£140 and grazing types £80-£90.
