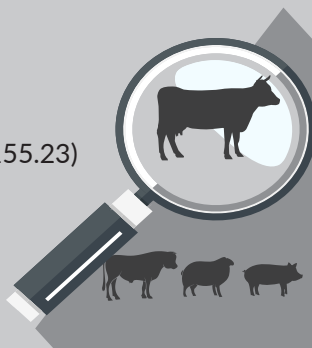

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

Prime Cattle -

As good a run as we have seen for some time topped today by a real corker from Passmore Brothers, with Limousin steers trading to 418p/kg, with AGM Farndon topping his run at 417p/kg, just ahead of DTP Walters with Limousins to 406p/kg. Dairy bred Herefords from AGM Farndon to a whopping 380p/kg.

Heavyweights from Passmore Bros to a top of £3160 for 756kg Limousins, with the same home trading to £2801. Edward Hull showing his usual stamp of big Angus lads sold to £2800 with AGM Farndon to a top of £2785.

Heifers -

Just wow! Some exceptionally finished heifers on offer and a real trade. Top today for Passmore Bros selling homebred Limousins to 426p/kg, 421p/kg and 420p/kg respectively, just pipping Parry Walters who saw 418p/kg and 416p/kg. Dairy Bred Blues from the Hull stable to 409p/kg with South Devons from L Lane & Son selling to 408p/kg.

Passmore Bros seeing big girls to £3109 for 730kg Limousin heifers. Dairy bred Angus heifers to £2953 ahead of Passmore Bros to £2938.

Bulls -

A very mixed show of bulls and trade competitive throughout.

P & N Allen saw handy weight dairy Blues to a top of 330p/kg on two occasions, with Limousins from DJ Hull to 311p/kg and Friesians from the Allens to 305p/kg.

Top gross to DJ Hull with Limousins to £3091, with Angus from the same home to £2858. Dairy sired Blues from the Allens sold to £1564.

Cows -

Young Hereford slips from PK Cobley topped at 272p/kg, with G Stretton seeing 260p/kg for meaty Angus cows. Thick meat actively trading 240p/kg with some absolute monsters in the entry today.

Top gross from RW Cross for 946kg South Devons topping at £2289.

Angus stock bulls from DJ Hull sold to £2684.

2300 lambs sold and seen with meat a real key to see an sqq 363p/kg!!! Meat well chased throughout. Shape and meat with the best audience topping at 426p/kg for Chiltern Beltex with small shape.

DS & LE Wadland then 414 to 418p/kg for pen after pen 40 to 44kg. W Bartlett and J Webster both taking 409p/kg for meat. Today meat and shape breaking 400p/kg for 22 pens in total. Export weights 41 to 45kg the real demand today and meat lambs 380-400p/kg. Lighter lambs 10p discount but still wanted. First cross meats lambs 350-380p/kg and grassy lambs short on meat 330-340. Stores less. Heavy lambs remain dear and trading equal ppk to Exports. Weight topping at 398p/kg for J Webster at 50kg. D Ofield 48kg at 396p/kg and Alwyn Williams 46kg at 387p. MM Clarke & Sons 49.5kg at 384p/kg.

In the gross the headline is that all in Avg £156!!! In July. In the Exports a top of £182 for 44kg from Messrs Wadland with J Webster 44kg £180 equal with W Bartlett. Overall the £200 mark broken throughout for meat topping at £213 for J & R Lowe at 58kg. Jiv Hollands £210 at 61.5kg and Messrs Milner 62kg at £209. Lambs End Ltd £208 and Williams and Bury £206.

CULL EWES: 705 FORWARD top at £242



With the show of ewes forward, a very respectable average of £132.64 must be commended.

Plenty of runs of lean, worked ewes in the entry today as the shortage of grass through the early summer has really hit home. Some fantastic runs of genuine grazing ewes forward this week and we look to have several more runs over the coming weeks.

As ever best Continentals an easy sell, but the entry today lacking real weight. Top today to £242 for a Charollais from Richard Lowe, with the same home selling Texel Rams to £236. B Burrows & Sons saw Texels to £229 with CE Cockerill to £220, just ahead of GL Woodard at £218.

Weighted Continentals all over £200, with medium ewes £170-£180 and smaller sorts £150-£160.

Suffolks to a whopping £230 for J & C Hinton, with J & R Lowe to £216. Weight £190-£200 with smaller sorts £160-£170

Mules to £181 for a massive sheep from Ted Taylor, with JH Mitchell to £170. Mules shorter on weight than previous weeks but thick meat £150-£160, with smaller sorts £130-£140.

Grazing ewes seeing better end Continental and Suffolk grazers £110-£120, with harder goods £80-£90. Mules generally seeing the better end grazers around the £90 mark with some poorer sorts £50-£60.

BREEDING SHEEP - 25.07.25

The year rolls around and we are back into our first breeding sheep sale, with just shy of 1500 penned.

A packed ringside saw bidding selective with the grass situation or lack of it in the back of everyones' mind.

Aged ewes through the ring to start saw a flock dispersal from Knight Agri, Coventry selling Full Mouth Pure Texel ewes to a top of £260, with Full Mouth Suffolks from the same home to £222, £200 and £197 respectively. Aged ewes with flesh and style seeing plenty of demand, while those harder done sorts more difficult to place.

On through into the Continental Theaves, which saw Chris Clayton take poll position with a pen of Black Texel Theaves, away to £290, with the same home seeing strong Texels to £240. Phil & Katie Cookes next in the ring carried on the strong trade with Charollais Theaves to £265 and £250 respectively.

The Birmingham boys represented well with Adam Neachell seeing his run of 150 Texel x Theaves to average £190.

On into the Suffolks, which saw our very own Jonjoe Morris selling some super Theaves to £252, with penmates to £221. Martin Woodward showing his normal quality with Suffolk Theaves to £228 and £226 respectively.

JL Barnes next in the ring topped his day at £214 on 2 occasions, with the run of 198 to average £203 with Turnstone Farming seeing a super run of stretchy, organic Suffolk Theaves to average £192 over 180.

Finally into the Mules seeing limited demand due to the early nature of this sale, but still selling to £210 for RJ Fox & E Murphy.
