VET ATTESTATIONS



Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

A good entry for August and despite the heat Buyers remain buoyant. Best end Cattle in demand equal to the flying trades in late Spring as where the heavies. Cold and young cattle meeting a little resistance with fields short on keep. Top for the day aged Steers from the consignment of L A Gibbs, Leamington Spa whom sold to £2250 & £2200 for 21m and 17m old Heifers to £1790. The younger proportion of the consignment seeing Steers 15m at £1660 with plenty trading around £1600. J Jackson sold Bucket Blues to £2000 for 24m Steers and D J Harris, Corley reaped the rewards of the livesystem and reapping hundreds of pounds per head more than selling from home when toping his run at £1990 for Angus Buckets for large pens at 18 months with others £1950 Limousin off Ben Harris £1850 17m. 17m Shape from Hollinshead Farms saw Limousin Steers to £1850 and sisters £1860.

Strength on the whole £115-£125 with better bred mediums selling £100-£105. Harder mediums £90-£95 with better smalls around the £80 mark. Harder smalls £65-£70 and still looking very well sold.

David Ofield feeding proper goods to a top of 426p/kg for Limousin steers, with BJ & IS Wain selling to 418p/kg for handy weight, box fed Limousin steers, with the same stable selling to 406p/kg. CW Thomas selling to 400p/kg for weighted goods, with LM & V Haskell up from Dorset selling to 399p/kg. Weighted Angus from Josh Trivett sold to 398p/kg, with TV & J Kenealy matching the figure with travelled Blondes.

Top gross seeing heavyweight Charolais from Dave Powers to £2971.92, with the same home exactly the same figure for Simmental. CW Thomas sold Limousin x to £2968 with LM & V Haskell to £2960.58.

LAMBS 2574 FORWARD

SQQ 344.7P/KG AVG £150 TOP £210

A swift slow in trade as numbers come out around the nation and grass lambs hit the Market. An SQQ of 344p/kg very very respectable but some Grass Lambs did return home for further feeding. Just over 2700 Lambs weighed today and the majority good meat. The other end though very short fed sorts and stolen from the land too soon. We did though have only 800 Boked in by Monday morning and told the buyers to expect 2000. We really do need people to book stock in prior to Sale.

Best meat still easiest sold but buyers very much focusing on price this week and premiums squeezed. Top end lambs today 405p/k & 400p/kg from DS & LE Wadland for pens 39,40.5kg and 40kg all Beltex and Dutch Spotted. A Morris 39kg Dutch Spotted at 400p/kg and C R Hill 41kg 400p/kg. Meat generally with shape 360p/kg plus and plenty in the 370p/kg's. First cross fed lambs trading 340p/kg plus throughout but light lambs remain the hardest to sell with the cost of Kill needing to spread across as many Kg as possible. Lean Lambs off the grass hovering around the 320p/kg mark and really needing feeding to make them weigh and to reach a wider audience. Heavies also back on the week proportionately albeit lean heavies hit hardest. Top in the heavies 392 at 48kg from A Williams whilst M J Woodward 47kg Blue Texels 391p/kg. Weight and shape from P Bodily 50kg at 384p/kg and 46kg from Humphrey Livestock. Those lesser fed 30p/kg less and lean weight hovering around 310p/kg.

An all in Avg of £150 though still amazing for August. Export lambs topping at £170 for 45kg for J S Busby up from Aylesbury and 45kg £168 for DS & LE Wadland whom also sold 42kg at £162 with CR Hull £165 at 45kg and BJ & IS Wain 45kg at £164.50. Plenty of Meat Export weights well over £150. Overall weight still stacks up and plenty of weight on show. Topping at £210 and £202 for Anne & Martin Morris with super Suffolk Lambs 59 & 62kg with HL Goode first for the year 66kg at £202 and BJ & I Wain £200 for 54kg.

Trade still very favourable. Lean lambs though at a level of discount never previously seen. Lean grassfed lambs want to be shown in the Stores ready for future feeding.

Another large yarding of ewes, with over 700 penned and sold.

Trade quoted as easier, however given the show on offer definitely no disaster. A fresh grazing account opening up and help to bolster trade, given the quantity of

lean grazing type ewes forward.

Best end ewes still easiest sold, with some fat sorts really ringing the bell. Charollais from C White selling to £230, with BC Burton selling to a top of £224. Proper Texel ewes from «Woody» to £222 equal with Charollais from C White. J & R Lowe saw Texels to £217. Meated continentals actively £190-£210, with leaner or lighter sorts £160-£170. Grazing types with potential £110-£120 with smalls £80-£100.

Suffolks to a top of £212 for heavyweights from DE Collett with John Peebles and Josh Nunnelly both selling to £208. Weighted Suffolks all over £200, with thick meated sorts £170-£180. Leaner goods £140-£150 with grazing types either

side of £100.

Mules flying with weight to £185 from T Wheeler, with Hyde Lane Farms selling big pens to £176. Weight all £160 plus with smaller meated sorts £130-£140 with grazing types just dropping under £100.
