Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

Prime Cattle -

Numbers shorter than last week and a better show of quality seeing trade firmer. Meat still key to making the most of your cattle and feeders should not be trying to draw cattle too soon.

Prime Steers -

Some storming sorts forward to a top of 430p/kg for a corking Limousin steer from Josh Trivett, with KS Mayfield down from Melton Mowbray selling to 429p/kg with weight. W Selmes, over from Oxford sold to 419p/kg with PC & RA Nichols seeing super Simmental steers to 415p/kg. Top grossing steers to £3131.70 for KS Mayfield, Melton Mowbray, with heavyweight Blondes from DR & JC Bennett selling to £3079.32. PC & RA Nichols sold to £3049.40 with homebred Limousins to £2958.16 from RW & HER Trivett.

Prime Heifers -

W Selmes seeing a proper heifer to 425p/kg, with DTP Walters selling to 410p/kg, with Passmore Brothers seeing Limousin heifers to 407p/kg. David Ofield saw properly fed types to 406p/kg and 398p/kg, with W Selmes to the same figure.

Top grossing heifers saw big girls from W Selmes selling to £3199.50 for 810kg Limousins with the same home to £3179 and £3016.84 respectively.

Prime Bulls -

Desperately short of bulls today and more wanted each and every week.

Top today saw Alan Tacy to 363p/kg with Chris Barnett grossing £2377.12.

Lambs;

Less about as rain arrives at last and Lambs prefer to eat the green stuff over the creep. Trade contracting again and plenty of trades under 300p/kg at the end of last week. Deadweight quotes giving no encouragement either as Sales slow as is seasonal.

Thankfully an SQQ of 308p/kg and 305p/kg overall posted putting us amongst the top Nationally for the day. Trade very difficult throughout with all categories dropping Nationally. Lean lambs with little or no audience.

Best end Lambs trading to 390p/kg for plumbs from J Bury and Beltex from DS & L Wadland 44kg at 373p/kg with others 361p/kg and 45kg at 356p/kg. Meat trading generally 320p/kg plus with first cross 300-320p/kg and lean lambs trading under. Weight also dropping but perhaps not as sharply as processing Lambs seem to hold their own. DS & L Wadland 49kg at 355p/kg and 349p/kg with A K Wilson 49kg for Rouge at 335p/kg and M J Woodward 47kg at 321p/kg. Weight generally 300p/kg plus if full meat and shape. First cross trading 290 plus. Leaner hard to fix. Overall an all in Avg of £136 still a firing return and ahead of the competition. Export lambs to £164 and £160 for 44 & 45kg for DS & L Wadland with others at £159. J Bury £152 at 39kg. Overall a top today of £190 for 70kg from E Grimley with J Bury 73kg at £180 x2 Plenty of weight still breaking £170.

Trade hard as Europeans return from Summer Holidays. A change in the weather and first pay cheques following Holidays should help to steady the ship.

Two fresh faces in the ewes saw trade considerably firmer on the week for all classes.*

Best meated Continental ewes still the easiest sell, with a corking Continental tup from Dashwood Partners selling to £255.

Rouge ewes from AK Wilson sold to £213, with Mel Hoyle seeing Texels to £201, just beating Anne who also sold Texels to £200, matching C & A Morley and RM Calcott. Continentals with meat regularly £170-£180, with leaner sorts actively £120-£130.

Best Suffolks to a top of £198 from Mark Humphreys, with Dashwood Partners to £192. Meated Suffolks generally £160-£170 with leaner sorts £130-£140.

Mules to a top of £176 for a monster from AK Wilson, with WH & R Weston to £170. Mules with weight general £140-£150, with leaner meated sorts £120-£130.

Grazing ewes a tidy trade with a fresh face here helping boost the trade. Continentals on the whole £100-£110 with grazing mules £80-£90.
