

## **CATTLE : 93 Forward**



*A change of voice and a tidy show of cattle just seeing a little bit of resistance from meat salemen. Shape and cover still remain the best way to maximise returns.*

### **Steers -**

*A tidy bunch of steers forward with some real power in the entry.*

*Top of the pops today saw handy shaped Blue steers from Pete Jarrom selling to 402p/kg, with handy weight Limousin steers from DR & JC Bennett selling to 400p/kg. CW Thomas topped at 395p/kg, with Messrs Bennett selling to 390p/kg.*

*Top grossing bullocks saw HW & AJ Eadon with monster Angus steers selling to £2870.40, with PC & RA Nichols selling Limousins to £2834, with the same stable to £2782. Natives striking again with Angus steers from Merris Bros selling to £2758, and R Ellis reaching £2619 also for Angus.*

### **Heifers -**

*A sharp bunch of heifers saw a top of 421p/kg for lovely little Charolais from Steve Friswell, with Blues from the Jarrom stable to 416p/kg. Extreme Limousins from J Cooper & Son sold to 412p/kg, matching another tidy little Charolais from Frizzy.*

*Top grossing heifers saw CW Thomas selling to £3018 for heavyweight Limousins, with Parry Walters to £2869 and £2868.*

### **Bulls -**

*A bumper yarding of bulls and well received by the buying support at ringside.*

*A corking little Blue bull from HW & AJ Eadon topped at 412p/kg, with the same stable selling to 400p/kg, 395p/kg, 385p/kg and 384p/kg. PM Wilks saw handy Limousin bulls to 383p/kg, with Stuart Friswell to 380p/kg.*

*Top grossing bull today saw big lads from the Eadons to £3160, with the same home to £3039, £2970, £2915 and £2887.*

### **Cows -**

*A much bigger yarding of cows than expected saw fed Limousins from Pete Jarrom to 310p/kg, with the same stable to 307p/kg and 303p/kg, with D & GM Wright seeing young Blue sired cows to 296p/kg. Natives from Robert Leach saw heavyweight Shorthorn cows to 287p/kg.*

SQQ 323.80P/KG AVG £144.40 TOP £194

Lambs;

Quality less on the week as a few Vendors cleared the deck for the year. Buyers short this week with last weeks trade too hot and lambs simply not dying at the moment as grass washes the lambs out. An SQQ of 319p/kg very swift albeit buoyed by a couple of good runs of smart meated handy weights. Export Lambs mainly trading 310-320p/kg with leaner lambs trading 300p/kg mark and middleweight lean lambs less. Best Export Lambs to 392p/kg for 42.5kg from MJ Woodward and 380p/kg at 38kg and 375p/kg for 44kg from Passmore & Nunnerley whom showed a marvellous run of meat Export Lambs. Shape lambs with backs regularly 350p/kg but lean lambs of any grade heavily discounted. Weighted Lambs with shape well chased and topping the entire day at 400p/kg for 48.5kg from Humphrey Livestock whom also sold 48.5kg at 386p/kg with Dutch Spotted from A Morris 47kg at 385p/kg. Middle of the road meat weight 300 - 310p/kg and lean weight 288-3295p/kg. Trade for common lambs harder throughout. An all in Avg of £144.40 throughout the yard. Export Lambs to £166.50 for 42.5kg MJ Woodward with Passmore & Nunnerley £165 & £165.50 at 44kg and AK Wilson 45kg at £160. IN the lump weight pays still and a top for the day of £194 & £187 for 48.5kg from Humphrey Livestock with A Morris, Hinkley £181 at 47kg and S Wrench £180 at 56kg equal with JK Smith & Son.

Trade certainly harder with the blues hitting the trade. Colder weather needed to draw shoppers out.

*Shape in short supply but topping at £246 for AK Wilson with Rouge Ewes ahead of Texel Rams at £231 from S Wise. Texel x Ewes from MJ Woodward £228. Continentals with weight trading past £180 throughout. Suffolks to £220 for RAE Wilson and WSE & CA Moreby whom also sold to £219 and £215. Weighted Suffolks less abundant but trading either side of £200 and even leaner weight £180 plus.
