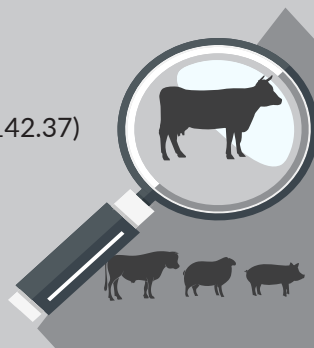

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

A change of voice in the rostrum and something for everyone included in the entry. Meat a wanted commodity and those properly fed cattle commanding a real premium.

Prime Steers -

Some proper corkers in the entry today with a super little handyweight Limousins from Tom Reeve to 439p/kg, with Pete Jarrom selling showy Black types to 434p/kg, just pipping NAS Johnson who topped his steers at 430.5p/kg. Weight from KS Mayfield topped at 424p/kg with Blondes from DR & JC Bennett to 407.5p/kg.

Top grossing steers saw thick meated Limousin steers from Morgan and Sansome to £3042, with KS Mayfield hot on their heels to sell to £3001, with the same stable to £2900.

Heifers seeing some much better sorts forward this week, with NAS Johnson to a top of 431p/kg, with Angus from R Ellis to 410p/kg for handy weights. Pete Jarrom saw Blues to 408p/kg, with GR Fountaine to 387p/kg Big girls from CW Thomas saw Blues to £2940, with NAS Johnson seeing Limousins to £2801. RW & HER Trivett sold to £2665, with Angus from the same stable selling to £2546.

Cows -

A show of worked cows, lacking cover. Weight from Ed Hull saw Limousins to 256p/kg or £2314.24. Stock Bulls saw White Galloways to 273p/kg or £2189 from FJ Baker Farms.

Lambs;

A short number of lambs and quality very poor on the whole with a lot of lambs short on meat. Trade steady all around and the leaner lambs having best audience from feeders. Best meat lambs though trading as fast as ever and quite seriously a flier with more accounts on for the best meat. Shape and meat today £4 and more per kg. W Barlett 41kg at 412 & 415p/kg for Beltex shape. DJ & ST Webb with blocky meat Texels at 42kg at 394p/kg and GR Fountaine & Son 44kg at 391p/kg. Shape meat lambs regularly 350p/kg plus as long as fed. Fed first cross 310 – 320p/kg albeit a harder sell with these lambs simply not ringing the bell at the shops. Lean lambs 280-290p/kg. Weight a hard sell today with all orders being told to buy at less. Meat shape though again bucking the trend with Messrs Fountaine 51kg at 373p/kg and W Bartlett 48kg at 371p/kg. N Deeley 46kg at 370p/kg and DJ & ST Webb 50kg at 365p/kg. Run of the mill leaner weight trading 280p/kg mark.

An all in Avg of £143 again and trade remaining favourable to vendors to feed.

Export lambs in the lump to 44kg and £172 for GR Fountaine & Son with W Bartlett 41kg £170 and others £169. DJ & ST Webb 42kg at £165.50. Weight though with meat still pays. The country now faced with Mule Weathers etc supplying the basic processing sector and as such grass weight discounted. Fed lambs though to £198 at 56kg for N Deeley with J & M Ironmonger 61kg at £192 and GR Fountaine & Son 51kg at £190. WJ Pearson & Son 60kg at £189. Plenty of weighted lambs still breaking £170 today.

444 FORWARD top at £262



A show of ewes that can only be described as mixed. Some super sorts forward but as ever large runs of grazing ewes slowing the average.

Top today for super Charollais rams from Hillside Farm selling to £262, with best continental ewes an easy sell today topping with Texels from M Cole to £250, ahead of Rouge from C Stubbs to £220 with Armstrong Partners to £207.

Meated Continentals generally £180-£190, with smaller meated sorts £150-£160. Leaner grazing types £120-£130.

Suffolks seeing weight to £220 from TJ Griffiths, with JA Boulton to £200 for Suffolks. Heavyweight Suffolks actively £170-£180, with lighter weight ewes £140-£150.

Mules with weight a real trade, selling to £186 for JA Boulton, with DC Hancock selling to £182. Meat generally £160-£170, with smaller sorts trading £130-£140 and grazing types around the £100 mark.
