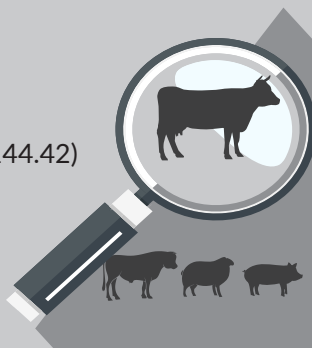

WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

A smaller show for our monthly RED sale, but trade firm and meaty goods as ever rewarded by the buying power at ringside.

Steers -

A corking little handyweight Limousin bullock from Tom Mann sold to a top of 416p/kg, with Passmore Bros selling Sussex sired steers to 414p/kg, and 412p/kg on two occasions. Weight from PC & RA Nichols sold to a top of 378p/kg with the same home to 376p/kg.

Top grossing steer sold to a whopping £3581.50 for an 1102kg Blonde steers from AT Mower & Son. PC & RA Nichols saw Limousins to £3085, with HW & AJ Eadon selling Limousins to £2975 at 33 months.

Heifers -

Those best end handy weight butchers heifer really ringing the bell, with Tom Mann topping here again with Limousins at 418p/kg. Quality short on the whole in the heifers with several underweight and overage sorts in the entry.

Top grossing heifer today saw Tom Mann to £2591 for Limousins.

Bulls -

A tidy show of bulls saw HW & AJ Eadon screaming ahead with proper Limousin bulls selling to 419p/kg, with the same home to 404p/kg and 399p/kg. Simmental bulls with weight from VM Bailey topped at 358p/kg.

Top grossing bull saw Simmentals from the Baileys to £3071, with the Eadon stable selling to £3062 for Limousins.

Cows -

A tidy a show of cows but in truth some starting to show the weather.

Top today saw Passmore Brothers selling to 278p/kg for heavyweight Limousin cows, with D & GM Wright selling to 270p/kg on two occasions.

Top grossing cows sold to £2112 for Limousins from Passmore Brothers.

Lambs;

Numbers across the country go tight and very much the same story here. Those on show though better meat on the week and fed lambs well received to see an SQQ of 324p/kg.

Fed meat top of the tree at 404 and 400p/kg for DS & LE Wadland with Hillside Farm 396p/kg for 45kg and Messrs Wadland 393p/kg. Export weights with meat well sold albeit buyers today with order for weight in general. Export weight with meat 370p/kg plus and first cross meat 330 - 350p/kg regularly. Leaner sorts trading in and around 300p/kg with some lean lambs better shown in the Stores with the current amazing trade for Store lambs.

Weight saw a top of 387p/kg at 47kg for DS & LE Wadland whom also sold 54.5kg Beltex at 385p/kg. Hillside Farm sold 47kg at 379p/kg and Messrs Wadland 48kg at 372p/kg. Weight regularly tracking the trade for Export lambs but lesser sorts seeing a lift on the week with heavies generally all over 300p/kg unless seriously heavy or very lean.

Overall an avg of £144.45 keeping track with 2025 seeing the best trade returns in history. Top in the Export returns saw 45kg at £182 for Messrs Wadland with Hillside Farm £178 at 45kg and Messrs Wadland £170 for 45kg. A Pittom 43.5kg £168.

Weight adding up though and £200 broken twice today. First for EJ Taylor £200 at 78kg with DS & LE Wadland £210 for 54.5kg Beltex. AK Wilson £190 at 63kg EJ Taylor 63.5kg £188 and J Hope Sheep Services.

Trade very acceptable but meat is key and more are needed.

A sharper show of ewes with more meat on offer. Top today saw Continental tups soaring to £340 for massive Texels from Boulton Bros, with the same home selling to £295 and £250. Continental ewes topping at £225 for Texels from MD Hamilton Farms, with J Hope selling to £218. A Freer saw Texels to £198 with the same home to £190. Heavy Continentals actively £170-£180 with smaller sorts £140-£150. Suffolks soaring to £206 for WSE & CA Moreby, with S & J Farming seeing massive ewes to £198, with the Moreby stable to £194. Weight generally trading £165-£175, with the smaller sorts £125-£135. Mules with weight short on the ground but topping at £168 from H Smith & Sons, with DP Jones and EJ Taylor both to £166. Meated smaller sorts generally £130-£140 with leaner sorts £110-£120.
