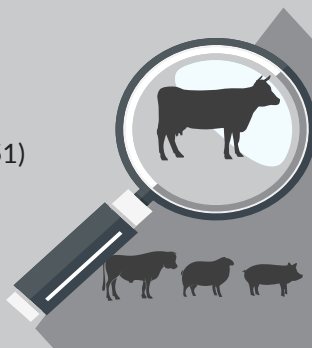

A tidy entry forward for our monthly red sale, with several AFU's and holdings under TB restrictions making the most of the ability to sell liveweight. Trade very much a stand on, with meated goods remaining wanted to fill fridges ahead of xmas trade.

Prime Steers -

Plenty of weight in the steers today, with big Limousins from Nigel and Simon Johnson selling to 419p/kg, ahead of Blues from NE Ross to 401p/kg. The Johnson boys struck again with heavyweight Charolais to 400p/kg, while JW & M Timbs saw Limousins to the same figure, just pipping Bert Mitchell who saw Limousins to 390p/kg.

Weight really adding up with NAS Johnson selling Charolais steers to £3168, with Limousins and Blues from the same home to £2983 and £2916 respectively. Monster Simmentals from JWH & MA Newbury sold to £2684 with H Smith & Son seeing Blues to £2630.

Prime Heifers -

A touch short of those very best end butchers heifers today, but the good on offer still holding their own. Top today saw handyweight Limousins to 408p/kg from PM Wilks, with Blues from the Ross stable to 400p/kg, just pipping Messrs Wilks who struck again at 397p/kg and 396p/kg. Charolais x from PM Jarrom sold to 388p/kg, with Simmentals from the same home to 387p/kg.

The Johnson boys flying high in the heifers too with heavyweight Blues to £2724, ahead of DJ Hull & Partners selling to £2475 also for Blue heifers.

Prime Bulls -

A much better entry of bulls today saw PM Wilks to 392p/kg for Limousins, with Bert Mitchell trading Simmentals to 387p/kg. HM Tomlinson, down from uttoxeter, topped their run of fed Blues at 380p/kg.

Top gross from HM Tomlinson saw Blues to £2644, with PM Wilks to £2524 for Limousins, just pipping Bert Mitchell who sold to £2492.

Cows -

Only a handful of cows today, saw a top of 274p/kg for L Smith Farming with H Smith & Sons to 263p/kg. Top grossing cows to £2033 for Charolais from L Smith Farming.

Lambs;

A miserable day of weather meant numbers short but more meat than we have been seeing met by a phenomenal trade equal to last weeks show returns with an SQQ of 344.26p/kg. Meat seeing buyers all around and plenty of meat lambs up and around 400p/kg.

Export weight lambs in huge demand and today weighted lambs seeing a lift also to cater for national shortages. V J Roots with Charolais x Beltex saw 43kg at 405p/kg and 44.5kg at 400p/kg with BJ & I Wain 45.5kg at 391p/kg and P L Mac, Leicestershire 37.5kg at 379p/kg.

Meated Export lambs all breaking 350p/kg with leaner first cross sorts 330p/kg plus and 40kg Suffolk Lambs today towards £150 a real return.

Heavies an increased trade. Topped at 46kg for Blue Texels from Nancy Wrench at 396p/kg at 46kg, R Woodward saw 47kg at 387p/kg with PL Mac 46kg at 374p/kg. Humphrey Livestock 48kg at 363p/kg. Weighted Lambs unless over 52kg regularly trading 320p/kg mark plus. Heavier sorts 300p/kg mark.

An all in avg of £151!!

In the lump export weight lambs to £178 at 44.5kg for VJ Roots with BJ & I Wain £178 at 45.5kg. Messrs Roots 43kg £174 and R Woodward 45kg at £170. Plenty of Export weight lambs in and around £150. Overall a top of £192 for 63kg with SJ & J Smith & Branson £190 at 70kg and S & J Farming 69kg £188 equal with Roger Woodward 65kg at £188. Rows and rows of lambs trading over £170.

Trade for meat exceptional. Today a run of Welsh mountain bred sheared Lambs fully fed returning over 350p/kg. Shearing and feeding ensuring a commodity in high demand.

Some fantastic ewes in the entry today, saw best end Texels from AM Beaumont selling to £300, with the same stable selling to £240 and £235. Texels from John Stephens sold to £234, with F Hodgkin to £212. Heavyweight Continentals trading £180-£190, with the better end of the mediums selling £160+. Smaller sorts £130-£140 and looking well sold. Suffolks soaring to £210 for heavy Suffolk ewes from S & J Farming, with Minshull Farms and AV Boffey both to £201, just pipping JA Boulton at £198. Heavy Suffolks £180-£190, with mediums actively £160-£170. Very few smaller Suffolks on offer but these generally £140. Mules a sharper trade, with RJ Wright selling to £186, with MJ Woodward to £178. Hyde Lane Farms saw big pens of 15 to £176 with weight generally £160+. Mediums £130-£140 with the leaner end trading £100-£110.
