

WELFARE STATEMENT



Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

A tidy show of cattle, with plenty of meat on offer. Trade reported as easier as deadweight quotations slide nationwide. Meat still key to maximising returns for cattle.

Prime Steers -

Short of those extreme shaped steers today, but better end sorts from GR Fountaine & Son selling to 386p/kg for Limousins, with the same home selling to 380p/kg. Heavyweight Limousin bullocks from R Ellis saw 374p/kg, with Angus from RW Cross & Son to 373p/kg.

Top grossing bullocks from R Ellis & Son selling Limousins to a top of £2894, with the same home selling to £2774. GR Fountaine saw proper Limousins to £2671 with Angus from JWH & MA Newbury selling to £2430.

Prime Heifer -

Some super butchers heifers forward with N & T Faulconbridge seeing fantastically finished Blondes to 415p/kg with the same home to 412p/kg.

Sweet meated Limousins from PM Jarrom sold to 390p/kg, with DTP Walters to 386p/kg. GR Fountaine saw Limousins to 384p/kg, with R Ellis selling to 380p/kg for properly meated Angus.

Top grossing heifers saw Parry Walters to £2617, with Limousins from R Ellis to £2541. Charolais heifers from Alan Tacy topped at £2533 with N & T Faulconbridge to £2521 for Blondes.

Prime Bulls -

A tidy show of bulls, with Pete Allen topping at 364p/kg for meated Blue bulls, with Herefords from the same home to 342p/kg.

Top grossing bulls to £2074 from Pete Allen for Blues, with Herefords from the same home to £1846.

NOTICE; Buyers have today stated throughout the UK that they are unable to any longer process lambs that are not belly clipped. This comes further to the rejection of 4 Lorry loads of Lambs in France on Monday Morning by the French Authorities whom deemed the lambs unfit for further sale due to dressing issues brought about by dirty bellies and crutches. This means that Lambs need to be Crutched prior to Sale by Vendors or using the Team that will provide the service within the Market.

More about today as the Summers effects start to wear off and Lambs catch up on meat. Meat much better throughout and demand very good. Some firms very price sensitive with Sales unseasonably difficult. Export weight and Butchers lambs best to sell with heavies starting to hit major resistance especially the overweight lambs. An Sqq though of 340p/kg a very fast trade throughout.

Spec lambs very well sold and plenty shape and meat breaking 400p/kg. Top of the tree 40kg at 408p/kg from the Amor family whom sold 100 plus well bred lambs to really hit the required spec. Beltex from Pritchett Farming sold 40kg at 405p/kg and Messrs Fountaine selling 42kg at 402p/kg and VJ Roots 41kg. Export meated lambs regularly 360p/kg with medium weights well chased 44-46kg and not seeing past discounts. First cross meat lambs trading 330p/kg plus with best meat and those 42kg and under easily 340 - 350p/kg. Leaner sorts trading 320p/kg mark. Weight today harder to sell throughout although meated shape a better interest. Topping at 404p/kg, Messrs Amor once again selling 47kg with T A Wrench 46kg at 361p/kg and Messrs Fountaine similar at 357p/kg. Meat weight still 340p/kg lus for those under 50kg. First cross weight generally 300 - 310p/kg with lambs 52kg plus much harder to place and trading 280p/kg and up.

An all in Avg of £147 to include a fair few lightweight Welsh-bred meated but small lambs. Export weight lambs topping out at £170 for 43kg from Messrs Amor and £170 at 45kg from V J Roots. G R Fountaine 42kg at £169 and Messrs Roots 44kg at £166.

Weight still hitting the top of the tree at £200 on two occasions both for D W Gurney & Son with 58 and 60kg Beltex.

Lamb sales really have not taken off yet with firms all reporting that they are not operating anywhere near capacity. We hope that a seasonal uplift commences in the coming week.

A much better show in terms of number, and meat, however very few of those very best Continental ewes forward today.

Top of the pops saw Texel tups from Fordwell Partners to a whopping £280 with the same home seeing Texel ewes to £252, just pipping A Pittom at £250. EJ Glover saw Continentals to £249, with Woody selling to £239 for Texels, just ahead of Kevin Armstrong seeing Texels at £228. Best continental ewes £210+ with the stronger end of the mediums selling £180-£190. Plainer sorts £160-£170 with grazing Continentals firmer £140-£150.

Best Suffolks to a top of £224 for whoppers from FI & EJ Barnes, with the same home to £212, just beating RS Hawkins who sold to £210 and £204.

Weighted Suffolks £190+ with medium types £170-£180, grazing sorts £140-£150 and looking well sold.

Mules soaring to £175 from H Smith & Son, with MJ Woodward to £170. Weight on the whole £160+ with smaller sorts £130-£140 and grazers around the £110-£120 mark.
