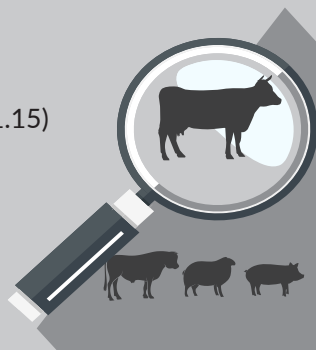

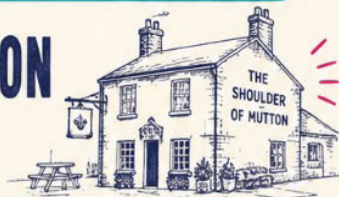

LAMBS 2689 FORWARD

SQQ 380P/KG AVG £171.15 TOP £254

The thick end of 3000 Lambs forwards as the dry plains of the Midlands start to draw feet off the ground. On the whole a better yarding of meat although a fair percentage of grass lambs looking very heavily hit by the weather. Meat though well chased and more buyers around ringside as Europe returns after Bastille day and the weather cools a little. An SQQ of 380p/kg resembled a lift on the week with buyers keen for numbers today and more spark around this week.

Top today from S Parry selling 39kg to 487p/kg for Dutch spotted with 45kg block of meat from JJV Holland 458p/kg and DS & LE Wadland 42kg at 450p/kg. J Herod 38kg at 447p/kg and Messrs Wadland then 444p/kg and 446p/kg.

Today Export weight lambs with finish and meat regularly trading 420p/kg and above. First cross lambs with meat 385-400p/kg and leaner sorts trading 370-380p/kg only the very lean trading under this. A 10p discount on the figures quoted in general for Lambs falling between 43 and 46kg with lightweights or heavies preferred seemingly by all buying Accounts. Weight still on fire and all guns blazing for heavies. Top today 446p/kg at 46kg for DS & LE Wadland Iso selling 47kg at the same rate and 49kg for 435p/kg with EJ Taylor & Son 53kg at 434p/kg and Martin Morris Suffolks 55kg and 431p/kg.

In the lump today an all in avg of £172 despite a yard of middle to lightweights including super lightweights.

Euro Lambs to £206 at 45kg with RJ Mawby 40kg at £200 and DS & LE Wadland 45kg at 444p/kg with S Parry Dutch Spotted Lambs at 39kg 487p/kg with N Sindens run of 200 topping at 45kg £190.

Overall massive numbers posted again with top £254.50 at 64kg for K Attfield and 63kg at £254. N Deeley 60kg at £250 with EJ Taylor & Son 60kg to £246 and Martin Morris Suffolks 56kg at £240

Weight and meat a serious trade all day.
