WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e. being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

Prime Cattle -

A much better show of cattle forward in terms of quality and number, with buyers at ringside fit for meat.

Steers -

A tidy bunch of steers forward, with shape and power key. Handy weights soaring to 415p/kg for Limousins from P Jarrom, with JW & M Timbs to 403p/kg. RW Cross & Son saw proper Angus to 387p/kg, with GJ Tolley to 382p/kg.

Top grossing steers today saw heavyweights from Parry Walters to £2865.12, with the same home to £2810.88. Pete Jarrom saw Limousins to £2705.80. Dairy Bred Blues from DJ Hull & Partners saw a top of £2650 with the same stable to £2626.

Heifers -

Wow, an absolute corker from Jane Gilbert roared away to 440p/kg for Limousins, with GJ Tolley selling to 412p/kg for handy weights, with the same home to 397p/kg. Tom Reeve saw Limousins to 382p/kg, with Simmentals from the same home to the same figure.

Top grossing heifers

sold to £2939 for Limousins from the Gilbert stable, with Parry Walters to £2842 for Simmental. DJ Hull & Partners saw £2454 for heavyweight Blue heifers.

Bulls -

A much better entry in terms of number but mixed yard of bulls, and mainly “R” grades. Topping the day saw Edward Hull to 370p/kg, with Longhorns from Alan Tacy to 360p/kg, matching Limousins from Ed Hull. Top grossing bulls sold to £2673 for heavyweight Angus from DJ Hull, with the same home to £2541 for Limousins .

Cows -

A corker of a Blue cow from Jane Gilbert saw 342p/kg, or a whopping £2722, with RJ Wright seeing slips to 301p/kg.

Hoggs;

Numbers still tight and the majority of todays entry travelling from southern counties. It seems the summers drought has held back root lambs thus far. Trade though spectacular and all accounts firing throughout. An SQQ of 354p/kg an absolute flyer. Best end in large demand and meat wanted throughout. Weight starting to get sticky as weight faces larger supply across the country and cheaper Irish and New Zealand cuts in London.

Export the driver though and demand strong. Topping at 428p/kg at 39kg for Beltex from C R Hill, Wigston and 39.5kg from Henry Tustian 415p/kg. C R Hill then seeing Export weight lambs 412p/kg x2, 407 & 405p/kg. P F Edwards with fed lambs at 42kg at 405p/kg. Turndale Ltd, Uttoxeter and Tustian all breaking 400p/kg.

Meated lambs in Export spec trading 360p/kg regularly with fed first cross also hitting 350 – 360p/kg. Leaner sort and those short on shape trading 330p/kg mark. Trade for small and City lambs very fast and as these dry demand likely to remain with rare breed sorts today hitting 350p/kg for 33- 36kg. Heavies harder sold as they become more prominent and January Blues hit the Catering trade. Top though seeing Beltex 48.5kg from H Tustian 379p/kg and Boot Farm Stable up from Reading with 48kg at 371p/kg. H Tustian 49.5kg at 364p/kg and GJ Lawrence 47kg at 362p/kg.

In the lump an all in avg of £153. Export lambs to a top of £182 for 45.5kg from Turndale Ltd, Uttoxeter with H Tustian £180 at 45kg and CR Hill, Wigston £176 and £175 for 43.5kg. C R Hill 42kg at £172. Export weights really totting up throughout. In the lump a massive top price today for a Charollais Whether from Harrison Bros at 91kg to £230!!!

£190 made of good meat from Leadbeater Services 61.5kg and A C Cook, Bristol 65kg with 65kg from GJ Lawrence £190 also. Plenty of lambs breaking £170 today and meat very well rewarded.
