

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

A much better show in number and quality, and wanted by a ringside of buyers all fit for cattle. Numbers like this are wanted every week and more could be sold to vendor advantage.

Prime Steers -

Some super sorts in the steer entry with GR Fountaine & Son soaring to 425p/kg for pure bred Limousins, just ahead of Parry Walters who sold to 416p/kg for Limousin steers. Weight from R Ellis & Son saw 385p/kg for heavy Limousins with the same home to 370p/kg.

Top grossing bullock today saw R Ellis & Son with a corking 876kg Limousin grossing a whopping £3171, with the same home close behind to £2864 and Parry Walters to £2820 for smart Limousin steers.

Prime Heifers -

A tidy bunch of heifers today saw Parry Walters to a top of 420p/kg for Limousins, matching with Blondes at the same price from N & T Faulconbridge. GR Fountaine saw purebred Limousins to 405p/kg with Blondes from R & T Reeve selling to 400p/kg. Heavyweight heifers topped at £2772 for Limousins from GR Fountaine, with R Ellis & Son seeing £2704 also for big Limousin girls. Blonde heifers from N & T Faulconbridge gross £2587 with overage Limousins from Wayne Bartlett selling to £2563.

Bulls -

After last weeks strong entry, a disappointing number forward today but some real quality. Parthenais bulls from NF Hodges topping at 418p/kg or £2656.

Cows -

A neat bunch of cows forward today saw slips from DJ Hull & Partners to 283p/kg, with JA & S Wrench to 269p/kg with the same home to 260p/kg. Top grossing cow to £2230 from DJ Hull & Partners

A wicked weekend of weather meant those that braved the floods deserved a reward. Trade for heavy lambs dropping nationally as the Catering trade struggles to keep pace with a wealth of large lambs coming to the trade. Sadly also supermarkets choosing New Zealand as a preference. Heavy lambs less money throughout but no disaster. Export lambs though simply a flying trade and well ahead of any prediction.

City lambs and lighter end Export weights really ringing the bell and an SQQ of 346p/kg showing a deadweight equivalent past 720p/kg. Light lambs seemingly in short supply and standing in the alternative situation to the heavies.

Top today some extreme Beltex from W Bartlett at 430p/kg for 40kg and 424p/kg for 34kg. RH Burman 40kg 418p/kg with G R Fountaine & Son 39.5kg 405p/kg. Norman Deeley, W J Prime and Messrs Bartlett all breaking 400p/kg. Meat and finished lambs 360p/kg plus with fed first cross lambs 345p/kg upwards. Lean sorts trading 330p/kg and over. Weight a harder sale throughout. Shape and meat though well chased to 391p/kg at 46kg for R H Burman with J & M Ironmonger 46kg 378p/kg. 50kg from Messrs Burman 364p/kg. and P & DM Hopcraft 358p/kg. Weighted lambs though 48kg plus generally 290 - 310p/kg with lambs over 52kg 280p/kg plus. The number of accounts for heavy lambs today halved.

In the lump an all in Avg of £147 still a swift return and very favourable.

Export lambs to £172 for 40kg from W Bartlett and £167 for 40kg from R H Burman with Norm Deeley 42kg at £164. W J Prime down from Derby at 45kg to £163. Gross today topped ay £193 for a super rouge from A K Wilson at 66kg and J Mills & Son, Northants 65kg £190. B T Caswell, Northampton £186 at 63kg and R H Burman £182 at 50kg.

Meat still the key. Numbers drying up of Export lambs and hopefully political influences worldwide wont rock the trade.

Best ewes in massive demand and seeing Charolais x from VJ Roots to £270 whom also sold Beltex at £255, £250 with Beltex from R Kellett £230 and Townsend Farm, Cherington £225. Pure sorts £220 plus and weighted Tups also breaking £210. Heavy first cross white face and Suffolks breaking £200. John Peebles selling Suffolks £202 & £200 and S & J Farming £195.50. Weighted White Face and Suffolks £170 plus throughout and leaner smaller bodied sorts £150 plus.

The edge of fat Ewes today again as a national supply of fat empties come out. Mules to £158 for Smith and Branson today with no real heavies on parade. Mues with meat hovering around £150 mark.
