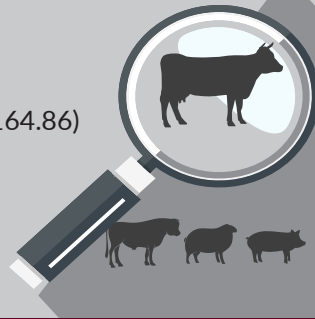

WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

CATTLE : 64 Forward



A handy show of cattle saw a touch more bite in the trade, with demand for meated cattle remaining strong. Another call to remind vendors that cattle must be presented clean for sale. While we all appreciate the weather has been awful, and the straw situation is difficult, cattle being presented with bellies covered with clags is not acceptable. We are all under increasing ministry pressure and we will come to the point that dirty cattle will be refused.

Steers -

A tidy bunch of steers but no real show stoppers in the entry. Dairy bred blues roaring to 392p/kg with weight from DJ Hull & Partners, just pipping Parry Walters with Limousins to 390p/kg. Weight from Hull stable saw Limousins to 380p/kg. Nice to see AEJ & FJ Claridge up with Devon sired steers to 367p/kg.

Top grossing steers from the Hull stable today selling to £2963 for Dairy Bred Blues, with the same home seeing Blues to £2856 and £2796. Limousins from Parry Walters topped at £2698 with handyweight Devons to £2473 from Messrs Claridge.

Heifers -

Sharp Limousin heifers from DTP Walters & Partners topped at 414p/kg, with Freeman Farming selling Blondes to 385p/kg, matching another Limousin from the Walters stable. Blues from DJ Hull sold to 369p/kg with Simmentals from Ivor Caswell to 356p/kg.

Top grossing heifers saw Parry Walters to £2599.92, with the same stable to £2541. Angus with weight on the Essex bus saw £2478, with Blondes from Freeman Farming to £2433.

Bulls -

A shorter entry than expected, but bulls a wanted commodity. Top today saw Alan Tacy to 344p/kg for Shorthorns with Pete Hemmings to 340p/kg, and a top gross for Alan of £2139.

Cows -

A mixed entry of cows meeting a firm trade. Top today from the Wrench stable selling stretchy Blonde cows to 280p/kg, with the same home to 278p/kg with British White slips to 272p/kg from GM Bennett & Partners. Top today saw JA & S Wrench to £2451 with Blondes to £2172.

Hoggs;

Simply ballistic todays trade. A yarding a little lacking in meat meeting an SQQ of 392p/kg!!! £8 dw wouldn't even touch it. Simply Supply and Demand Internationally driving Sales it seems with even internal Wholesale Markets more buoyant.

Buyers in determined moods with City & Export weights very keen and returning Butcher buyers also able to compete.

No real shape or exteme lambs about today but those with any sort of confirmation in hottest demand. Top for the day 36kg at 467p/kg and 38kg 442p/kg from Hull Farms, Essex whom sold 222 Lambs to avg 396.7p/kg. All clean bellied and empty Hoggs. Run of the day though would have to go to Passmore and Nunnerley whom had full meat Hoggs that weighed like lead weights full of flesh. Seeing 45kg at 436p/kg and 40kg at 435p/kg. Rows of lambs over 400p/kg and 43kg and less with meat all trading 400 to 420p/kg. Heaviers again at a 10p/kg disadvantage like for like. First cross export Hoggs 390p/kg plus and only very lean 360 - 370p/kg. Heavies also moving trade forward well and Passmore & Nunnerley topping out 48 & 49kg at 409p/kg also selling 46kg at 402p/kg with J Duggins down from Derby to sell 46kg to 400p/kg. Meat & Shape weight all over 390p/kg. First cross and heavier sorts 350 - 370. Super heavies 310 - 320p/kg.

TODAYS HEADLINE; *An all in avg to include a fair percentage of Hoggs underfinished or lightweight avg £165!!!*

Export Hoggs today topping at £196 for 45kg from Passmore and Nunnerley whom sold 106 to Avg £180! Humphrey Livestock sadly only found a small lorry full but topped at £188 for 44kg with Messrs Hull, Essex £186 at 44kg. Plenty of Export Hoggs over £175.

Overall the £200 mark breached and topped at £201 for NF & K Redfern at 59kg with Passmore & Nunnerley 49kg at £200 and H L Goode & Son £200 at 60kg. Rows of lambs £189 to £197.

Simply a flyer and thousands more could have been sold with some buyers unable to start. Meat needed.

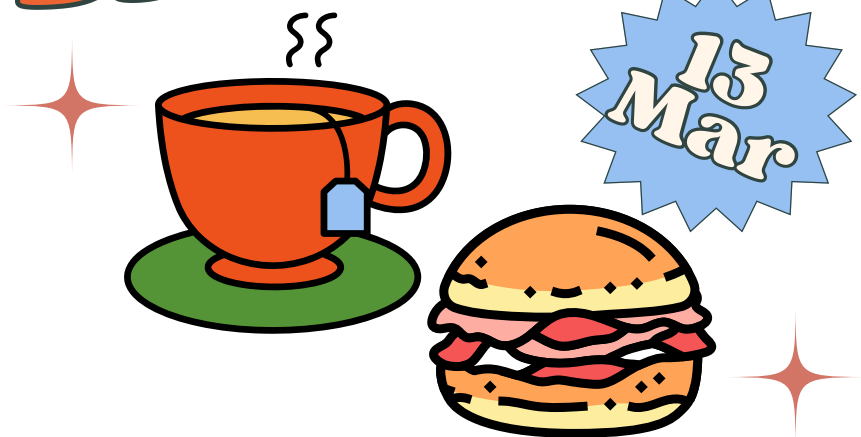

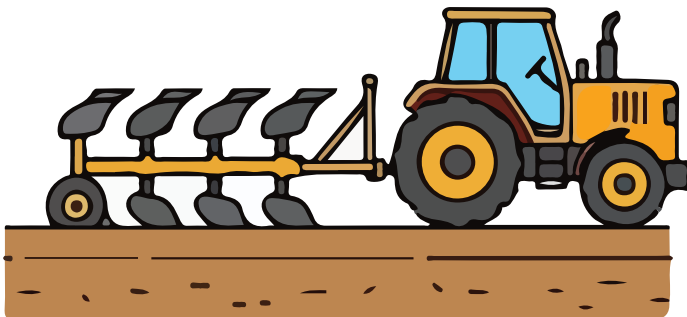
