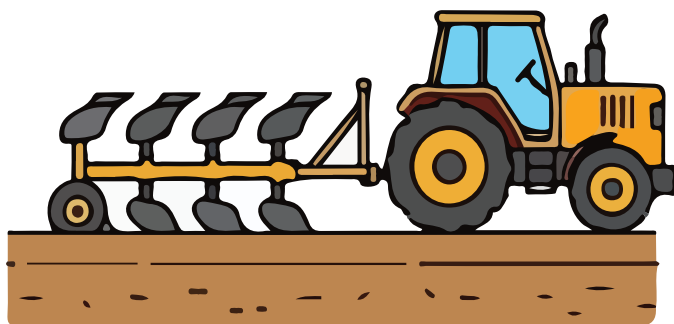

Prime Cattle -

Trade holding firm yesterday despite the continued slump in meat sales. Fed cattle remain wanted at ringside, with butchers and wholesalers competing at levels above deadweight quotations. More numbers are desperately required in all sections, with customers present for all classes of clean, bulls and cows.

Prime Steers -

Top bullock today saw handy weights from PM Jarrom to 392p/kg, with N & T Faulconbridge seeing big Blondes to 368p/kg. Tom Reeve saw Simmentals to 360p/kg, with Limousins from the same home to 356p/kg. Angus steers from HW Holberton sold to 312p/kg.

Top grossing steers saw N & T Faulconbridge with Blondes to £2752 ahead of PM Jarrom selling to £2532 for Limousins.

Prime Heifers -

A super heifer from Parry Walters topping the day at 416p/kg, with N & T Faulconbridge selling to 406p/kg for Blondes. Parry saw heavier heifers to 394p/kg with JD Stephens to 375p/kg.

Top grossing heifers sold to £2655 from Parry Walters, with Messrs Faulconbridge to £2606 for Blondes.

Cows -

Young cows sold to 272p/kg from RA Deeley, with EC Parker selling to 250p/kg for Shorthorn Cows.

An SQQ of 422p/kg simply flying and Farmers must take a moment to appreciate the value of Lamb currently at the shop counter. Lets hope the demand can absorb this going forwards. Export Hoggs and small Hoggs in massive demand from start to finish. Meat massively rewarded. Topping today at 38kg and 471p/kg for P F Edwards. Humphrey Livestock 44kg at 463p/kg. Tommy Tustian 38kg at 461p/kg with H & J East 461p/kg and Humphrey Livestock 40kg t 460p/kg.

Today plenty of Export Hoggs over 440p/kg for best meat and shape. General Export Hoggs trading 430p/kg mark throughout with 44kg plus 10p discount. First cross and 420p/kg plus generally and very few under 420p/kg. Heavies a royal trade and two months ago the doldrums in the catering trade aisle all but forgotten. Topping today at 46kg and 439p/kg also selling 47kg at 434p/kg. Shape and meat from J & H Tustian seeing 52kg at 433p/kg and 46kg at equal money and T Baker 48kg at 433p/kg. Meat Hoggs all flying to 420p/kg and plenty of super heavies striding out to £4.

In the lump an all in avg of £187. Export trade saw massive gross figures throughout topping at £203.50 for 44kg from Humphrey Livestock and £200 for 45kg from WG & SW Jones with S & D North 45.5kg at £198. Overall though top prices to new levels topping at £240 and £239 for Joe Hope Sheep Services at 65 and 67.5kg with Rosie Leach 71kg at £237. Breaking £230 today Tommy Tustian, Hope & Sons x 4, LT Parrott & Sons and J & H Tustian!

MM Clarke & Sons with a Texe x Charollais at £300 and S Kellett £300 also. White faced crossed from J Hope Sheep Services to £270 equal with R Leach. Plenty of weighted white faces over £240. Rams today to £250 for R Laing and £240 for WJ Pearson & Son. Run of the Mill white faced Ewes short on weight £180 plus with fat the only limiter. Into the young Summer Cattle and annual supply from Jenson Pallett Supplies met fierce interest for the 11m old Blues trading to £1945 & £1700 with sisters to £1405. South Devons from JW Lawton, Market Bosworth saw the grazing men awake to sell to £1450 at 11m and Angus to £1575 at 10m.

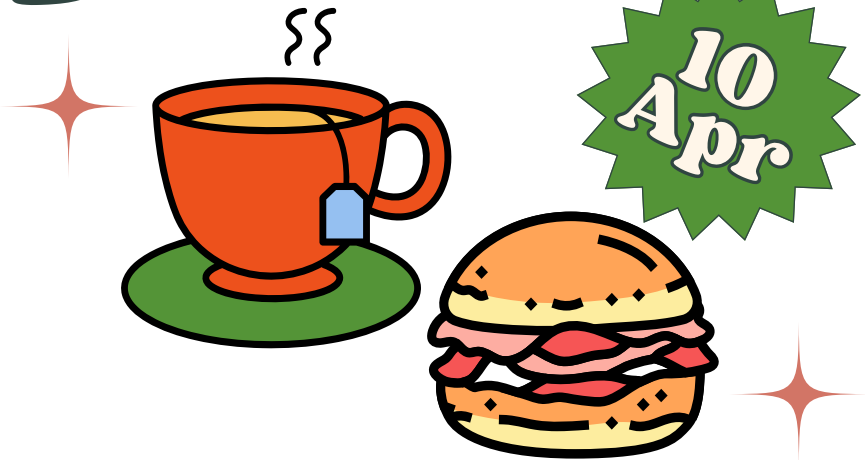
