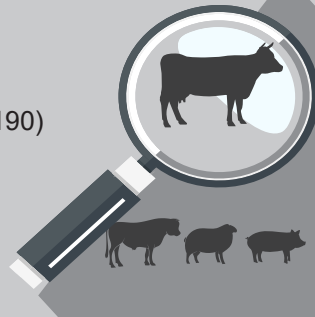

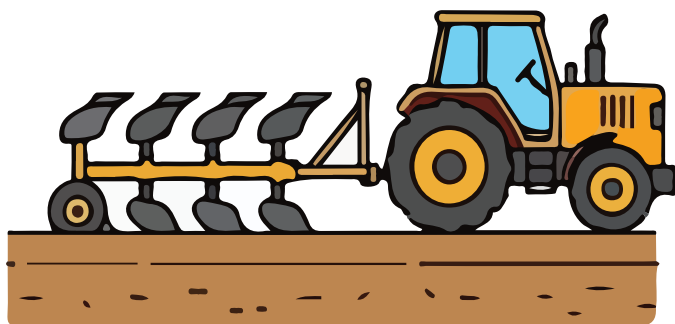

CATTLE

Prime Cattle -

A better show in terms of number, and meated cattle rewarded with the trade, albeit at levels in line with falling deadweights and slow end product sales.

Abattoirs continue to want numbers to maintain kill throughput.

Prime Steers -

A real corker today topping from Angus Russell selling to 404p/kg for Blue Steers, with Sansome & Morgan selling to 380p/kg and 374p/kg for weight respectively, with Charolais from the same stable to 370p/kg and 360p/kg. Simmentals from R & T Reeve to 348p/kg, with Hillside Farm to 340p/kg for Charolais.

Top grossing steers saw Sansome & Morgan with Charolais to £2627, with Limousins from the same home selling to £2622. Blues from WJ Russell saw £2424, with Charolais from Hillside Farm to £2366.

Prime Heifers -

Angus flying high here too with hopper fed Blue heifers to 411p/kg, with Shorthorns from the same stable to 398p/kg. R & T Reeve saw 390 for Limousins with GM Bennett seeing Charolais x South Devons to 338p/kg. Top grossing heifers saw R & T Reeve selling Limousins to £2425 with Shorthorns from WJ Russell to £2372. Angus heifers with weight from A Sabin selling to £2274, with Charolais from GM Bennett to £2109.

Prime Bulls -

Best end bulls today from Jasper Hart seeing Blondes to 409p/kg twice, with the same stable to 350p/kg. Black and Whites from Pete Hemmings saw 329p/kg twice.

Top grossing bulls from Jasper sold to £2503, with the same stable to £2494.

Cows -

A much better yarding of cows saw RW Cross with slips to 292p/kg, with JK Smith & Son seeing the best of their cows to 280p/kg on 2 occasions, with others to 278p/kg and 277p/kg.

Top grossing cows saw slips from RW Cross to £2324, with JK Smith selling Simmentals to £2121, with others from the same stable to £2090.

SQQ 434.15P/KG AVG £190 TOP £236

Hoggs; All in Avg £190 – Passmore and Nunnerley sell 80 Hoggs to avg 49kg and £203.68p!! 28% of the yarding breaking £200!

Less numbers about as vendors aware of the end of Ramadan and wary of trade drops. No need to worry though as trade driven by Export and a limited amount of Antipodean Supplies currently getting through to our shores. An SQQ of 434p/kg a massive return for a yarding short on meat compared to last weeks. Best end Lambs in huge demand as are lighter Export Hoggs with plenty of these selling past 440p/kg.

Top today just a tad short of 500p/kg at 495p/kg from Passmore & Nunnerley saw 40kg with Mentor J & H Tustian then 492p/kg at 38kg and 45kg 489p/kg with young pretender Tommy Tustian 40kg at 488p/kg. Today any shape striding past 470p/kg.

Meat Hoggs 450p/kg easily passed with only over 44kg discounted with Exporters and City Sales wary of gross costs. First cross all nearly passing 430p/kg except very lean Hoggs 44kg plus trading less. Export and City weigh Hoggs today needing £9dw to be competitive!

Weight Hoggs now very much in fashion and trading well throughout. Topping at 451p/kg at 47kg from Roger Coombes with real shape and weight with JA Boulton 47kg at 447p/kg and Tommy Tustian 46kg at 439p/kg and Jack Leason 46kg at 435p/kg. Weighted meat striding past 425p/kg regularly. Weighted Hoggs all around the 400p/kg and massive returns.

Today's all in Avg £190 to include rows of three quarter meat sorts. In the lump Export Hoggs to a massive £220 for 45kg from J & H Tustian with W J Prime 45kg at £210, Passmore & Nunnerley 44kg at £202 and R Avery 45kg at £202. TODAY 41.5kg from Henry Tustian hits £200!!

Plenty of Hoggs in the Export weights over £190 and meat all breaking £180.

Overall a top of £236 & £234 for George Scrivens at 71kg with W J Prime £230 at 59kg and VJ Roots £230 60 to 61kg with this price matched by Adrian Hope at 61kg. Weight and meat totting up and all meat wanted with buyers accounts aplenty.

We now monitor to see if demand continues to stomach the price.

Numbers short but trade strong. Fat harder placed than in recent weeks but an all in Avg of £180 a flying shot. Demand slightly off the boil due to last weeks Festival but returns still quick. Top today Blue Texels from P Bodily at £265 with meium weighted Shape and today no heavy weighted shape forwards. RJ Mawby with Charolais x at £255 twice and V J Roots £250. Plenty of shaped Ewes over £230 but no weight in that category. First x White Faces to £232 from A Peck, Norfolk and this good home selling weight regularly past £220. White faces all over £200 if meat. Suffolks to a top of £226 for A Peck and £224 and £222 for Marcus Labram. Suffolks full of weight today and most over £210 unless very fat.

Mules to a massive £203 for Welsh Mules from RJ Wright whom also sold at £200. Mules to £188 for RJ Mawby but run of the Mill meat eitherside of £158. Ewes likely continuing to hold massive demand.

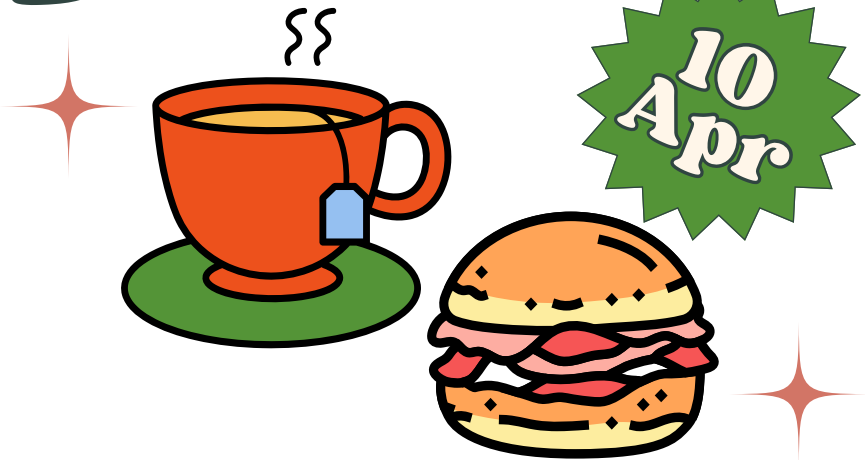
