WELFARE STATEMENT

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame i.e. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

CATTLE

A better show in terms of number and quality, with a shade more interest at ringside and 3 returning accounts opening up for cattle. Numbers continue to be required and cattle today trading ahead of deadweight quotations. Meat trade for beef under continual pressure with slow sales and full fridges reported in all corners of the country.

Prime Steers -

Some super bullocks forward seeing some tidy top prices.

Topping today saw super Limousins steers to 400p/kg from DJ Hull, with the same home selling to 390p/kg. N & T Faulconbridge saw homebred Blondes to 379p/kg with Parry Walters seeing weight to 360p/kg. Handy Simmental steers from T Barber & Son sold to 348p/kg, with R & T Reeve to 347p/kg.

Top grossing steers saw heavyweight Simmentals from DJ Hull to £2712, with N & T Faulconbridge selling Blondes to £2637. Dairy Bred Blues from DJ Hull sold to £2580, with the same home to £2561 all with weight.

Prime Heifers -

Heifers with weight to 388p/kg for Blondes from N & T Faulconbridge, with the same stable to 382p/kg. T Barber & Son saw real Simmental heifers to 379p/kg, with DTP Walters selling to 370p/kg and 360p/kg respectively. Charolais x heifers from W & M Emery sold to 348p/kg.

Top grossing heifer from N & T Faulconbridge saw Blondes to 388p/kg, with W & M Emery topping at £2600 for Charolais. Ed Hull to £2548 for heavyweight dairy bred Blues, with Parry Walters to £2476 with the same home to £2412.

Bulls -

More bulls forward and a mixed show, but all wanted by the ringside buying support.

Top today saw Honesberie Farms to 350p/kg, with P & N Allen selling Blues to 344p/kg. Blues from Freeman Farming sold to 329p/kg with the same home selling Simmentals to 329p/kg. Black and Whites to 300p/kg from P & N Allen.

Top gross saw Honesberie to £2849.

Cows -

Cows to a top of 262p/kg from Woods Farm Meriden for young slips, with the same home to 261p/kg.

Top grossing cow a big Charolais from JC Bostock & Son to £2083.

SQQ 419P/KG AVG £190 TOP £231

Hoggs;

Numbers tight nationally with Farmers eyes on lambing duties. Hogg trade though for Export and City Hoggs very dear and trading all over 430p/kg. 44kg plus and lean Hoggs harder placed but an SQQ of 419p/kg a fair return for a yarding short on meat. Top today from the Amor family with nice sorts at 480p/kg at 40kg and N Deeley 42kg at 474p/kg/ W J Prime with Fed Hoggs at 472p/kg for 41.5kg and C J Page 42.5kg at 467p/kg. The few better sorts on show today all travelling past 450p/kg. Run of the mill meat 430p/kg and only heavier end and lean less. That said a few major companies wanting to give 20p less than the trade and preferring to swap to Spring Lambs at the first opportunity. Weight with meat a nice trade and 47kg at 436p/kg for N Deeley and 48kg 431p/kg for V R Phipps. Messrs Duggin, Derbyshire 48kg at 427p/kg and R Avery 46kg at 422p/kg. Weighted first cross Hoggs short on meat much harder placed and trading 360p/kg plus with super heavies a plenty chased harder.

In the lump an all in avg of £190 maintained and some marvellous averages sustained with L Bolton, Windsor, load of 145 super heavies returning £215.

Export Hoggs topping at £208 for 45kg for W J Prime with R Avery 44.5kg at £204 and R Honesby & Daughters 44kg at £202. Norman Deeley 42kg at £199. Plenty of Hoggs north of £200 and today top £231 at 66kg from L Bolton with RJZ Farming 83kg at £230 and Messrs Bolton £229 with WH & IM Butcher 63kg at £227.

A notable mention for Martin Woodward today selling 60 Badger faced Hoggs to avg 425p/kg. Many more Hoggs needed and wanted.
