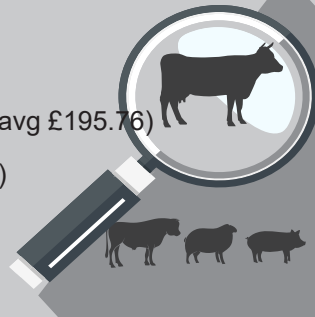

Following a meeting with Warwickshire Trading Standards & the FSA on Monday we have been asked to highlight the Welfare Issues being reported from the Abattoirs regarding Cull Ewes. These mainly relate to MASTITIS & LAMENESS. Condition Score i.e being very thin.

Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severely lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

A better show of cattle, and trade in truth slightly firmer. Meat still wanted and numbers required at this new level of trade as plants continue to require throughput.

Prime Steers -

Some shapey steers forward, and a pleasure to see Cecil Thomas back in the ring with Limousin x steers to 380p/kg on two occasions. WJ Russell & Son saw Limousins to 370p/kg, with RW Fox & Son seeing Charolais to 342p/kg, 341p/kg and 338p/kg. Simmentals from DJ Hull sold to 339p/kg.

Top grossing steers to £2644 from CW Thomas, with the same stable to £2629. DJ Hull sold heavyweight Blues to £2579, with R & T Reeve selling Limousins to £2539.

Prime Heifers -

Some tidy heifers forward today, seeing a top for Blues from W & M Emery of 360p/kg, with DJ Hull to the same figure for homebred Limousins, with the same stable also selling to 342p/kg. W & M Emery sold to 336p/kg for Blues with PM Jarrom to 330p/kg, equal with Angus from J & P Seymour.

Big girls from Ed Hull saw Angus to £2423, with the same stable selling properly bred Limousins to £2390. Angus from the Jarroms sold to £2174, with Blues from W & M Emery selling to £2073.

Bulls -

Desperately short of bulls, with Simmentals from VM Bailey selling to 350p/kg or £2233.

Cows -

More cows wanted each week.

Top today saw VM Bailey selling to 249p/kg or £2106 for Simmentals, with J & R Hall to 208p/kg or £1672 for exceptionally fat Hereford cows.

The only reason to call the Spring Lambs a steady trade is in comparison to the Hogg Trade. Absolutely flying from start to finish for a yard of mainly end of Season Hoggs and an SQQ of 450p/kg and all in avg of £206!!!!!!!!!!

All Buyers with bigger orders than they could fill and sending Wagons in relay to collect.

No proper Beltex sorts forwards but those with finish and any sort of shape a flyer. Top 500p/kg for 43kg from M & C Morris ahead of N Deeley 44kg and 42kg at 491 and 486p/kg. FJ Baker Farms next at 39kg and 485p/kg with P F Edwards 484p/kg and J Hope Sheep Services 480p/kg. Shape 470p/kg plus and run of the mill meat 460p/kg plus in export weights. Heavies a serious trade £20 upon the week. FJ Baker Farms again showing the way when selling 46kg at 476p/kg and Matt Morris 48kg at 456p/kg with H J East 46kg at 455p/kg and 48kg at 453p/kg. Plenty of heavies 450p/kg with those 52kg plus 400-430p/kg and even supers heavies 340 – 360p/kg.

In the lump Exports to £216 at 44kg for N Deeley and £215 with WJ Hemming 45kg at £211 and Messrs Edmunds up from Caerphilly with real meat at 45kg to £209 ahead of Humphrey Livestock 45kg at £206.

Numbers starting to come out but that not quenching demand. An SQQ of of 483p/kg a flyer and remaining in unseen territory with an all in Avg of £195 this despite a good number of grass only Lambs today. Those sweet shaped fed Lambs seing a serious enquiry albeit all Ovine now reaching such heights in the shop that it is very much a luxury good. Top today to 535p/kg for 38.5kg from P Cobley down from Leicestershire with Messrs MG & SM Grindal 36kg at 528p/kg both for Beltex. Texels from D & GM Wright at 38kg to 524p/kg and Pritchard Farms 37kg at 516p/kg. Leam Farms, Daventry then selling pens full at 514 & 513p/kg. Today 35kg to 40kg the order of the day and anything fed selling 500p/kg plus. Grass Lambs trading 470 to 484p/kg. Weighted Lambs with weight selling today to a top of £229 for 57 for MM Clarke & Sons with B Burrows & Son 48kg at £225 equal with 53kg for M Fox and Leam Farms a large pen at 47.5kg to £224. Plenty of meat wanted.

Ewes saw white faces after Messrs Roots to £250 for Robert Leach and Messrs Grindal equal with D Edwards at £248 before Charolais from Stuart Friswell £248. White faces with weight £210 plus albeit medium weights £188-£205 looking dearest. Suffolk Ewes short of size today but to £202 for T Wheeler and H White. Cotswolds with weight to £228 for G Scrivens. Mules today the heaviest sheep on show and topping at £192 for Welsh from RJ Wright with Messrs Bolton £186. Mules generally £170 plus if weighted and mediums again much dearer trading £140 plus.
