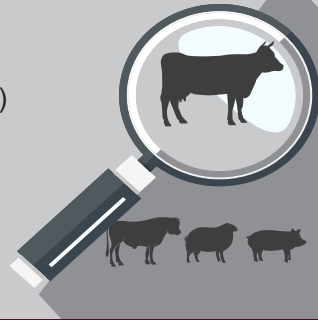

A short show again and trade remaining level. A touch more bite in the better end but still plenty of pressure from end users with floods of imported meat available at cut prices.

### Prime Steers -

The first outing following the Quarbani Festival. Smaller Asian retailers all on slow orders but larger processors fit for lambs and trade simply a flyer. Quality much improved on the week and appreciated by buyers. A sharp increase in trade and deadweight equivalent pennies away from £10 per kg. Finish the key but better end lambs regularly miles past £5. Top today 526p/kg for SM & JM Lambert at 38kg with E Brain & Sons Ltd equal money ahead of 39kg from Alan and Jemima Collett at 521p/kg and C & A Morley and PM Wilks 40kg at 520p/kg. Today plenty of Lambs over 500p/kg and meated lambs all 490p/kg plus. Grass sorts and those over 44kg trading a little less and around and generally 475p/kg plus with only the lean sorts less. Weight very well chased and meat really rewarded at 46kg and 497p/kg for TJ Griffiths with MR Grindal & Son equal money and GR Fountaine & Son 46kg at 491p/kg. Weight today in big demand. In the lump Export Lambs to a massive £226 for David Ofield and J Webster at 44kg with R Avery 45kg at £225. E Brain & Son 43 and 44kg at £221. Weight though totting up and a top of £248 for CW Thomas at 54kg with J Bury 57kg at £241 and B Burrows & Son £240 Hyde Lane Farms £239.

Trade simply marvellous. Numbers likely now to come out and we move towards the summer when trade should be monitored. Long term trade looks healthy and Vendors should not rush Lambs away under finished. Meat is really paying
